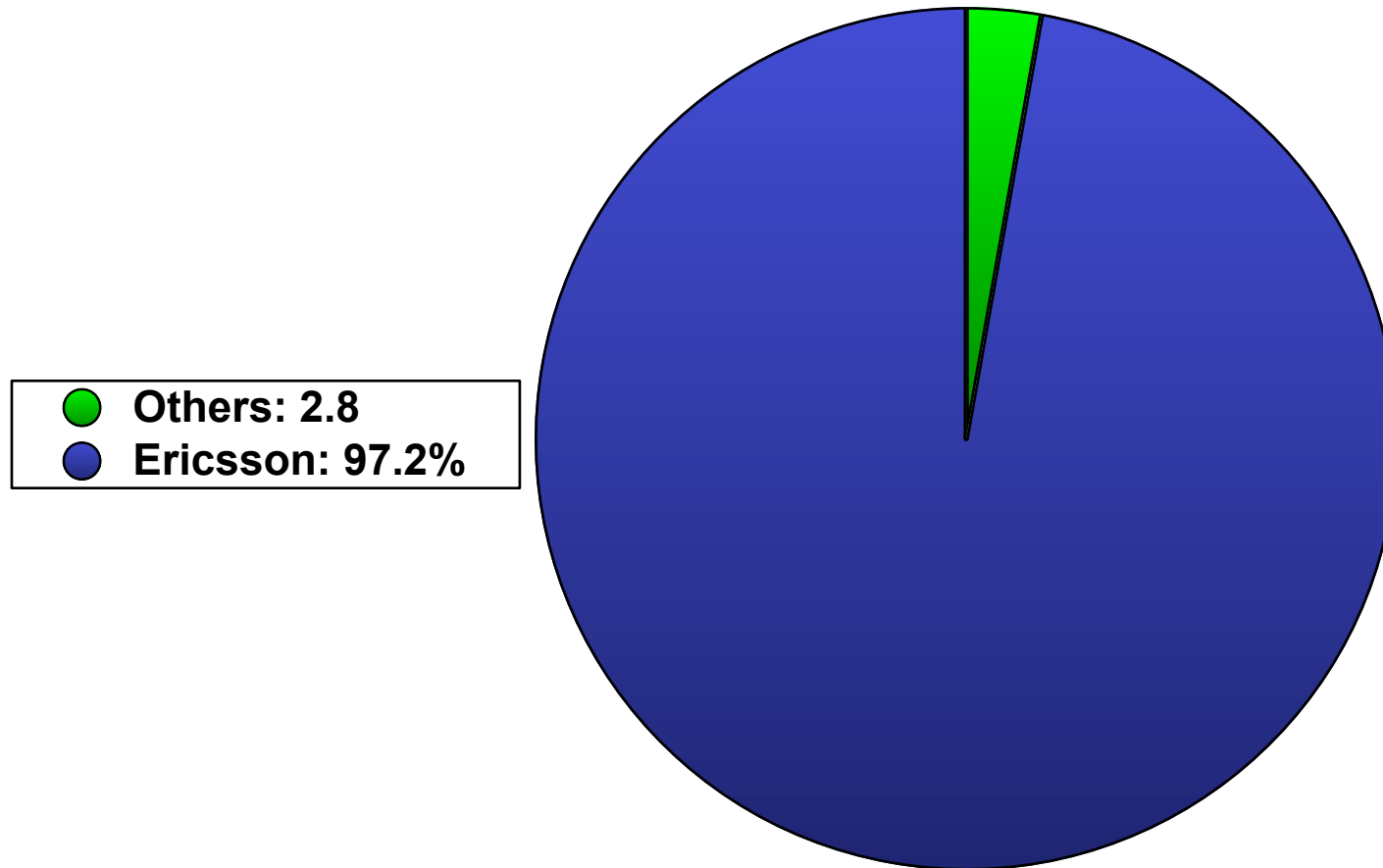

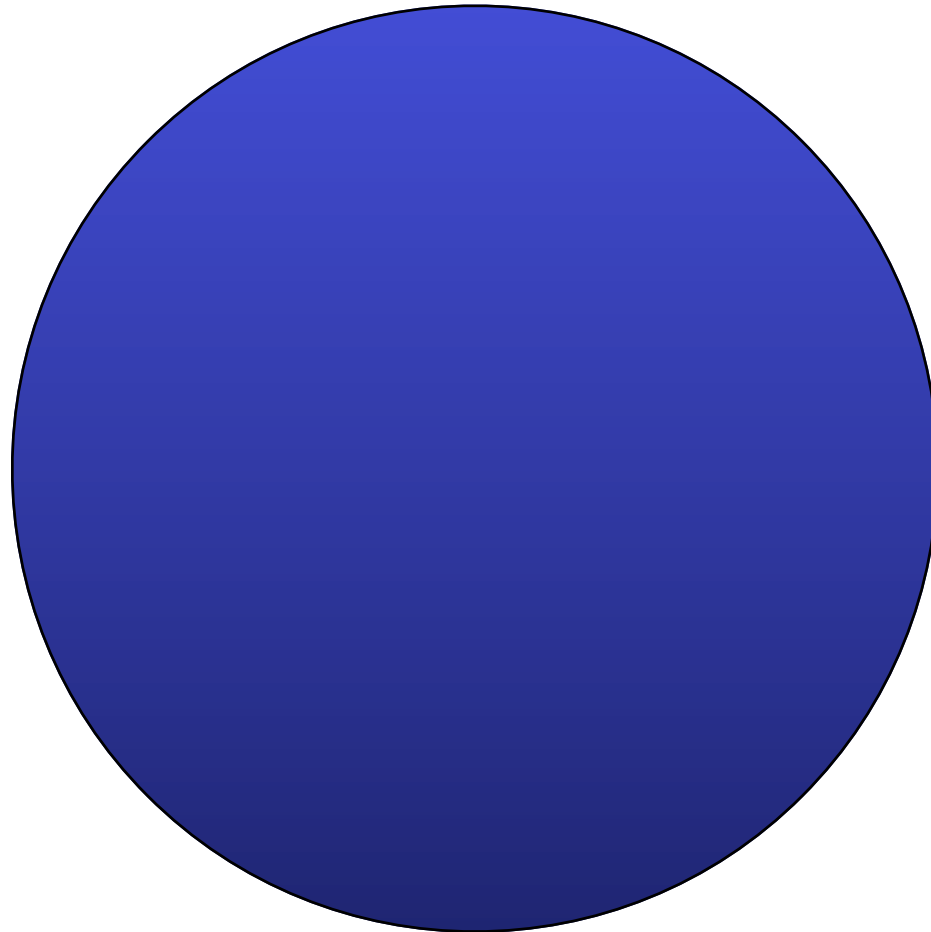

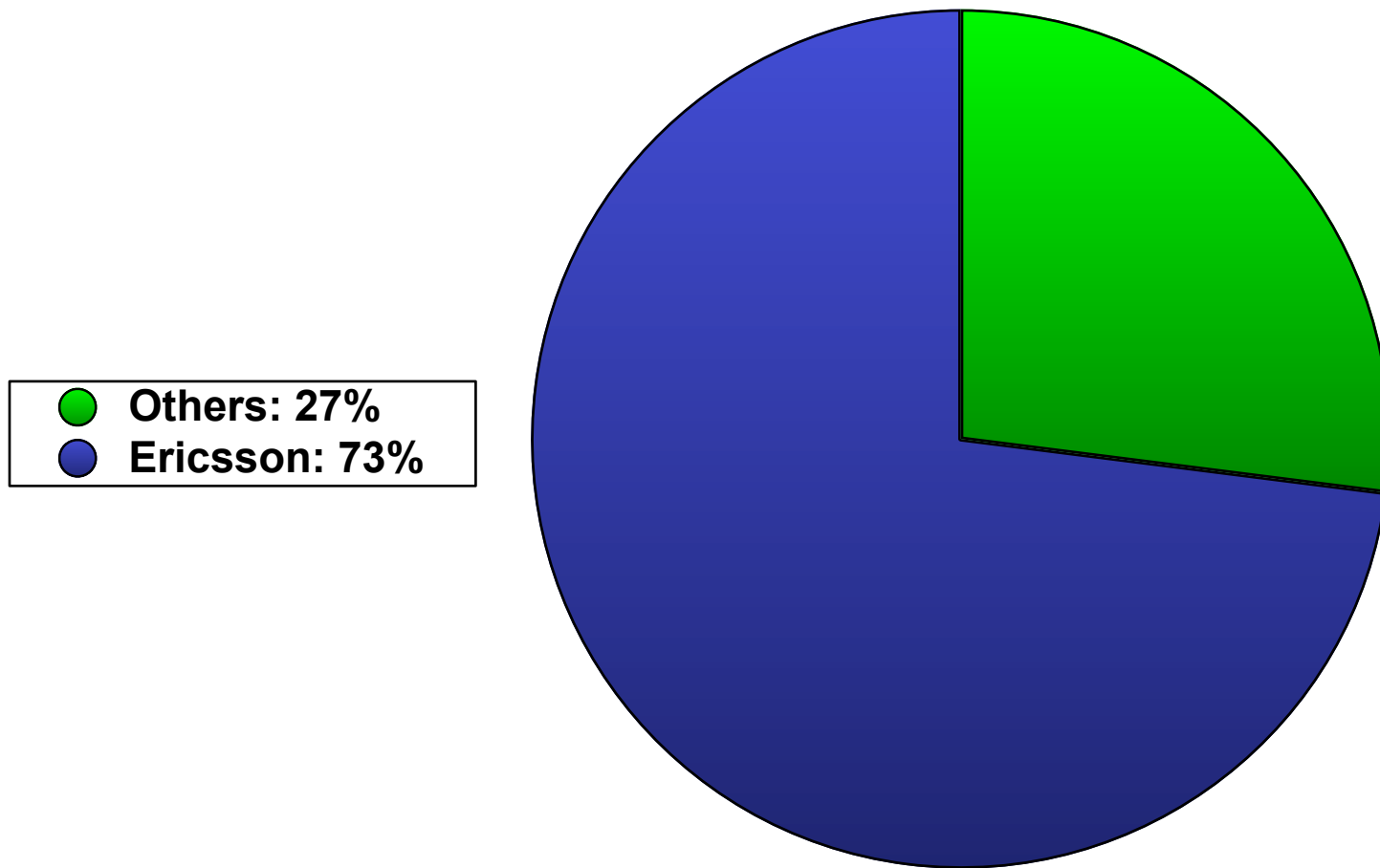
Turnover 1999 - 2000



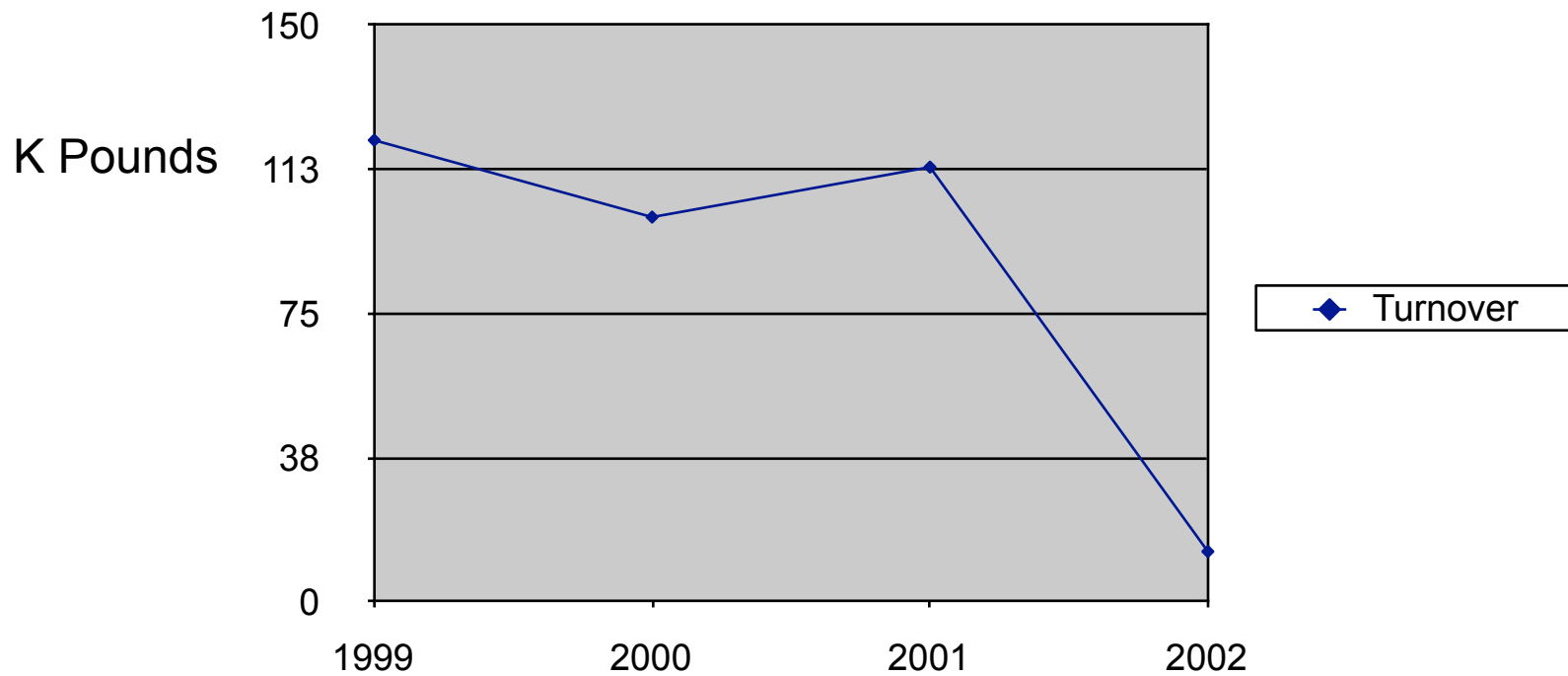
Turnover 2001



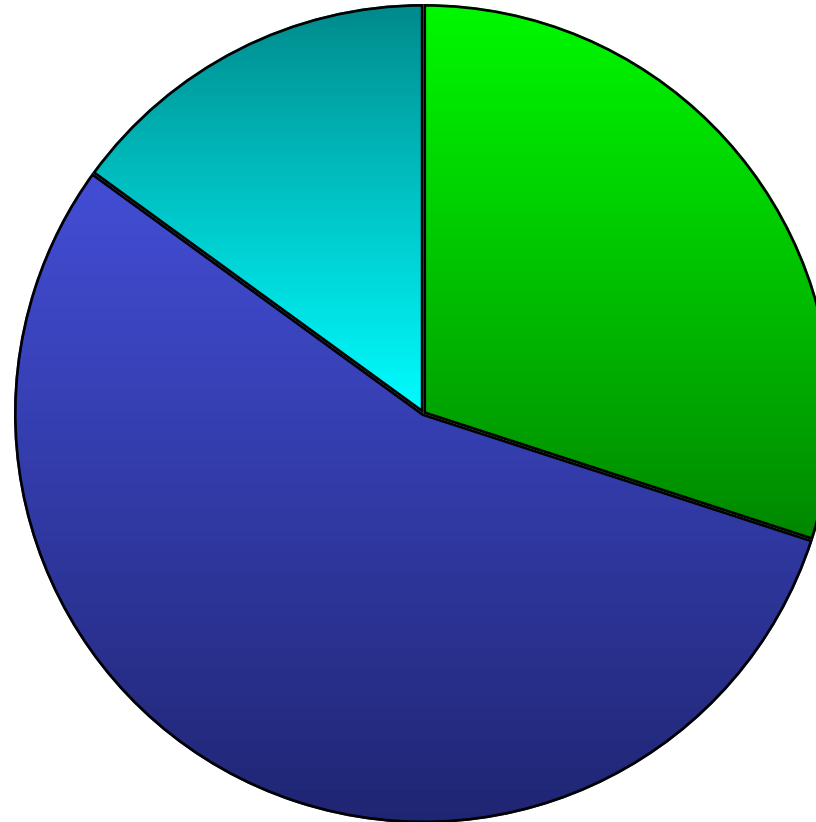
