### Finding Online Databases:

The Ewing Memorial Library subscribes to various scholarly databases through HEC Digital Library as well as its own institutional subscription such as Jstor. To search scholarly articles and ebooks on History & Pak. Studies please consult the following databases

JSTOR is an archival database that includes full-text content of more than 1,300 academic journals, 21000+ JSTOR ebooks as well as thousands of primary sources. It allows accessing 100+ scholarly journals in Full text on World History studies.

Oxford Handbooks Online (OHO) is an outstanding collection of the best Handbooks in Humanities. The Ewing Memorial Library has received access to this valuable E-collection, through AMICAL Consortium providing access to a total of 100 titles in three subjects i.e. **Literature, Classical Studies** and **History**. 36 Oxford Handbook titles are downloadable both in form of chapters & Full text for the subject of history.
