The Jewish Daily Forward celebrated yesterday its thirty-seventh birthday anniversary. Under the editorship of Abraham Cahane, the Jewish Daily Forward has grown and developed into the most widely read Jewish newspaper in the world. It exerts widespread influence upon the masses of the Jewish working people. It is a live, wideawake and courageous organ of public opinion.

The secret of the great success of the Jewish Daily Forward lies chiefly in the journalistic genius and the youthful and enterprising spirit of its editor-in-chief, Abraham Cahane, one of the most colorful personalities in American Jewry. In Cahane are blended the finer qualities of the Russian intellectual, the Jewish maskil, the Socialist educator and popularizer, and the American journalist and publicist. Cahane also attained high distinction in American literature as a novelist and short story writer, but his devotion to the Forward and to the Jewish labor movement caused him to sacrifice his own literary career.

Mr. Cahane is assisted by a staff of brilliant and experienced writers, while the business department of the Forward is conducted by Mr. Wladec, a man of high culture and remarkable executive ability, who also finds time and energy to help numerous worthy humanitarian causes.

**The Gotthel Medal**

The annual Gotthel Medal will be presented this year to Rev. Dr. Everett R. Clinchy, of New York, Father J. Elliott Ross, of Charlottesville, Va., and Rabbi Morris S. Lazarov, of Baltimore, Md., for outstanding services rendered to the Jewish people during 1933. These recipients of the medal have travelled during 1933 from coast to coast, spreading the gospel of good will and better understanding among Protestants, Catholics and the various religious faiths in widely needed, and have also had spring from ignorance and superstition.

But there is no special distinction about the Gotthel Medal. The medal is usually made in a haphazard manner. In one instance the Gotthel Medal was bestowed upon a man who did not deserve any medal for anything he has done for the Jewish people, and who has since then disgraced himself and the Jewish people.

Bitterly attacking the United States Treasury Department for its refusal to exclude German goods marked with the names of various German cities and states instead of the country of origin, as required by law, Samuel Untermeyer, president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, declared last night at a concert held under the auspices of the organization in Carnegie Hall that "a more ruthless, wilful defiant record of violation of our laws that these officials are sworn to enforce and disregard of the rights and interests of our merchants and consumers would be difficult to imagine."

## Paris Bodies Lack Money For Refugees

**Are Forced to Curtail Aid; Palestine Is Only Hope for Them**

PARIS, April 22.—Because of lack of funds, emergency committees for helping German Jewish refugees and East European Jews here have been forced to restrict their activities to a great extent. To all appearances the only hope for the masses of Jewish refugees in France and of the poorest East European immigrant families is to succeed in entering Palestine.

The Palestine bureau here is flooded by thousands of applicants and certificates, but the number available does not exceed several dozen.

The situation is regarded as critical, especially for nearly a hundred Jewish immigrant families in Lille, Lens and Valenciennes, who are treated with importation unless they obtain certificates permitting them to go to Palestine. All efforts on their behalf have thus far failed to secure the necessary papers.

## Austrians Widen Relentless Drive Against the Jews

**Exclusions Become More Drastic Every Day, Causing Many to Leave Land—Nazi Concepts of Life Openly Preached to People**

## Poland Can Halt Anti - Semites, Paper Charges

**Need Only Display Firmness It Has Shown Against Others**

LONDON, April 22.—In order to "prevent a raging, tearing anti-Jewish agitation from gaining speed" in Poland the government of that country need display only half the firmness it has shown against the peasants and the Socialists, the Manchester Guardian said yesterday in a leading editorial on the newly-founded Polish anti-Semitic, pro-Nazi party.

The party referred to in the editorial was formed by a group, believed to be predominantly academic, which asserts that the Endek (National Democratic) party is not sufficiently anti-Jewish and anti-government. According to information now available, professionals all over the country are flocking to the ranks of the new group. There are said to be at least three hundred Nazi agents in Poland.

If the Polish government does not take the firm stand necessary, the Manchester Guardian says, "it is taking a terrible risk."

## Many 'Non-Aryan' Lawyers Lose Out

**Figures Show Alarming Decrease in Prussia for Last Year**

BERLIN, April 22.—From thirty-nine to seventy-three percent of "non-Aryan" lawyers and notaries in Prussia have been deprived of the right to practice during the past year, figures now available show.

Last year there were in Prussia 3,378 "non-Aryan" lawyers. This year there are only 2,066. Of last year's quota of 2,048 notaries, there are today 884. In Berlin there are today only 1,237 of both categories.

While the average decrease in the number of "non-Aryan" notaries was fifty-nine percent, it amounted to seventy-three percent in the city of Kassel. The general decrease in the number of "non-Aryan" lawyers in Prussia was thirty-nine percent.

VIENNA, April 22.—The process of excluding Jews from the Austrian theatre and the boards of the large communal and professional organizations is continuing relentlessly, with the circle of exclusion widening every day, although officially there is no anti-Semitism in Austria.

The process appears to be a secret one and when cases of discrimination occur, as they do almost every day, it is impossible to fix the responsibility for the gradual and ever growing exclusion of the Jews.

The Neue Welt, Jewish newspaper edited by Robert Stricker, leader of the Austrian Revisionist Zionist group, declared that several Viennese theatre directors have stated that the Viennese theatres are adopting the Hitlerite methods and that Jewish actors are being gradually excluded from the theatre.

It is practically impossible for a Jewish actor to obtain an engagement in a Vienna theatre unless he is a star for whom no substitute is available, it was stated.

When engaging actors exceptional precautions are taken to question them to ascertain whether they can prove that they have an "Aryan grandmother" and can be placed under the "Aryan clause" which is strictly enforced in the Third Reich.

**Many Leave Land**

The Neue Welt points out the large number of Jewish musicians connected with the stage who have left Austria in recent months owing to their inability to find employment.

The newly chosen board of the Union of Austrian Journalists, which was appointed "authoritatively," does not include a single Jew, despite the fact that there are many notable Jewish journalists in Austria. Similarly the newly appointed board and the administrative committees of the state insurance company do not include a single Jew, although thousands of Austrian Jews hold positions in the state insurance company.

"Bodenstaendigkeit" has become a household word in Austria, as frequently used as "gleichgeschaltet" is in Germany. While the word has no clear meaning, the anti-Semitic Austrian Nazi paper, Der (Continued on Page Eight)

Why the Jew Must Suffer
The capacity of the Jew to dramatize himself and every experience in his life, together with his religiously inspired piety, yesterday as well as responsible for his racial suffering through the centuries by Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, speaking on "Must the Jew Suffer?"

Dr. Wise said:
"The Jewish view of life is a tragic view. But the Jew must feel that he is suffering, and feeling ever and ever to change it. We cannot escape our historic fate. So let us bear it with dignity, courage and nobility."

He asserted that "the sensitivity of the Hebrew is the reaction to memories of many years of torment and poignant suffering by a sensitivity to forget." "The torch-bearing Jew must not be the sufferer. It is the one who carries a torch into the world who must feel that sense of apertness and loneliness which is the lot of the Jew."

"The greatest test in life is the ability to forgive as well as to be forgiven," declared Rabbi Samuel H. Goldenson in his weekly sermon Saturday morning at the Temple Beth Shalom, sixty-fifth street and Fifth avenue.

"There is in reality no forgiveness if it is not accompanied by a willingness to forgive," the rabbi said. "Most people feel that they forgive when they say, 'Well, I'll forgive but I don't think I shall ever forgive.' That is not forgiveness. You are not so distant about opening your heart. What use is forgiveness if your heart is locked?"

Another sermon he said, was a generous heart. "It is not easy to be generous when we must make a sacrifice," he added.

"The divorce laws of New York State have been liberalized by the Legislature even though the Ros amendments do not go far enough," said Louis I. Newman held in his sermon yesterday morning at Temple Rodoph Shalom, 7 West Eighty-third street.

"Happines is achieved by the two parties to the marriage in their relationship to each other, and the divorce laws put in effect upon the dissolution of a marriage which spiritually has already been destroyed."

His Nordic Myth
The Nordic myth which is being utilized as the cornerstone for building the Nazi state is so hopelessly false that only the most energetic can believe in it," Rabbi Isaac Goldstein asserted in his week-end sermon at Congregation B'nai Jehshurun, Eighty-ninth street and West Broadway.

"The leaders themselves must know better," Rabbi Goldstein maintained. "They are foisting this myth upon their people because it gives them a new instrument. In the first place they can by the race myth raise the nation up to a boiling point, and then make ready for the day of battle."
"Is more immediate utilitarian value is the displacement from industry, government, government service of hundreds of thousands of Jews and the replacement of them by Aryans—so much easier a solution to the unemployment problem of the Aryans than the additional suffering by improving actual conditions."

"It seems hardly possible that statehood founded on such a lie can go on for the long time whose example of brutality and mendacity Nazi Germany is now emulating, and even surpassing, have crumbled and stronger the Third Reich seems to be, the nearer it is to the day of reckoning."

Truth Crushes Slender
That calumny is doomed in the presence of honest opinion was the contention of Rabbi Joseph Zeitlin of Temple Anshe Chesed, West End avenue at 100th street, in his week-end sermon.

"Rabbinical literature, the Jew," he belittled to be smitten with his malady because he was guilty of speaking "slander," Rabbi Zeitlin declared. "There is a difference between the Jew associating what is physically wrong with what was ethically abhorring. Untold unwhanices can be brought to man because of his tendency to defend his property."

"The recent occurrence in Washington in which attempts were made to besmirch the sacred reputation of the late president and his aide—fame has no legal because falsehood has no leg to stand on."

Anti-Nazi Duo To Be Tried at Gates Av. Court

Will Appear on Friday; Blue Men Rally Tonight

Rudolph Jurkowich and Louis Meyer, the latter a member of the National Blue Men, will face charges of seditious conspiracy Friday at the Gates Avenue Magistrates' Court, arising from the rioting at the celebration of Hitler's birthday by a mob at Schwaben Hall, Brooklyn, last Friday night.

Jurkowich, who lives at 808-A Broadway avenue, and Meyer, who resides at 122 Utica avenue, Brooklyn, were arraigned before Magistrate David L. Malbin in the Gates Avenue Magistrate's Court last Friday and were paroled until Friday. Alderman Walter R. Hart, Blue Men attorney, is representing Meyer.

Tonight the Blue Men will hold a rally at Empire Manor, 70 Third floor avenue, Brooklyn, where a refuge from a German concentration camp will describe his experiences. Other speakers will include Magistrate Oswald J. Strahl, Ben Lazare, National Blue Men executive officer, and Phil Cook, counsel to Lazare.

Communists Join Meet
Five hundred Blue Men attempted to invade Schwaben Hall last Friday night in protest against the celebration of Hitler's birthday. Kept out by police, they waylaid the celebrants as they emerged after the meeting. A free-for-all ensued and the seventy police commanded by Deputy Sheriff Nellig were helpless as Communists who had been holding an open air meeting a block away joined in the riot.

Aid flying sticks and stones, Meyer and Jurkowich, who were injured in the fighting, were arrested on the grounds, including these two, were treated by a doctor from the Wyckoff Heights hospital who had set up an emergency hospital. Many sustained minor injuries as a result of the riot, but did not apply for treatment.

Pink Praises Housing Plan For Lower East Side Poor

Louis H. Pink, member of the New York City Housing Authority, spoke on the Housing Program at a luncheon meeting of the Civics Committee of the Free Synagogue at the Henry Street Settlement offices, 22 Park Avenue, Saturday afternoon.

Commenting on the proposed projects to be undertaken in the East Side, Mr. Pink said, "Many are in the opinion of the city and authorities should not attempt a project on the lower East Side because of the high land value. I think that the high land value does present a real obstacle to the achievement of low rents but we should not give up just because it is difficult."

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MENCKEN ON PRAISE

The following is the last of a series of four articles by the former editor of American Mercury, author of a score of books dealing with American culture, one of the most popularly recognized as one of the country's leading critics.

Broadly speaking, there are two kinds of colonies. The kvuzas is held in a romantic, everything is pushed in common, and every member is expected to do his right to the usufructs. The moshav is more individualistic; each member has his own place of land and works it himself. But even on a moshav all buying and selling is done cooperatively, and the more expensive kinds of farm machinery are owned in common. In the moshav type colony is hired labor permitted. The early colonists used to employ Arabs to work for them, but that is prohibited on land owned by the Fund. A farmer on a moshav must work his own land—with such aid, of course, as he can get from his family and his neighbors.

A moshav looks pretty much like any other group of small farms. The one called Nahalal, established in 1921 near the nearby town of Ramat Hashikma, is perhaps typical. It runs to nearly 2,000 acres and supports about 700 people. In the center are the community houses, including a school for farm girls, and around them in a circle are the homes of the farmers. Behind each home are the barns, and behind the barns the orchards and vineyards, and thereafter the land of each farmer stretches out to the bounds of the colony, ever widening like a slice of pie.

N. J. Farmer Is Colorist
In company with Mr. A. L. Fellman of the Jewish Agency, I dropped in on one of the farmers. He was out in the fields at the time, but we were received politely by his young daughter. On a shelf in his living-room was a long row of technical books—on poultry, on grape-growing, on fertilizers, and so on—most of them in English. He came in presently and showed us his Leghorn chickens, and pointed with pride to a scheme he had devised to make it easy to clean their yard. Then he showed us his pet cow—a prize milker in those parts. Then he took us to his orchard and his vineyard, and pointed to his fields beyond. This man was once a farmhand in New Jersey. His wife did not appear. It turned out that she was taking her sister.

A typical kvuzas is Ein Harod—

2,250 acres, 320 workers, 200 children, 300 cows, 5,000 eggs in the incubator, fifteen acres in olive trees, thirty acres in grapes, seventy in grapes, twenty-five in vegetables for the table, thirty in a eucalyptus wood-land, a four-mile, a planting-mill, a machine-shop, 120,000 grafted grape-vines for sale by the nursery. It lies on the northern slope of the Valley of Jezreel. Behind it, on the hilltop, is a square, white, granite building, seventy green rows, its fields run down in a magnificent sweep to the mountain which bounds the valley on the south. In fact, this is the railroad, which runs eastward to Trans-Jordan, and then north and south to Damascus and Medina.

The Ein Harod brethren are communists of the highest voltage. They will raise their babies in common. When a child is born it is taken in hand by professional nurses, housed by a young and very scientific-looking doctor, and led to a school. The school is the largest and finest building on the grounds. When it arrives at the age of three it is transferred there, and will be quarantined there with a dormitory upstairs, and there it labors under other professionals until it is six. Then it goes to school, and begins to live with its mother. What is the scheme? I can only report that the children all looked healthy, and showed excellent manners to strangers.

The Arab Threat

Ein Harod, of course, is no mere farm. Its mills bring in quite as much as its lands, and its nursery for trees and vines, managed by a very intelligent man, Mr. Aaron Friedmann, is famous throughout Palestine. It was founded in 1921, and is still in the full flush of its life. "When will it last? Probably not. As soon as its present kindergartners grow up they will begin to marry outside, and then there will be quarrels on the street, and it will no doubt go the way of Brook Farm, Amana and all its other predecessors. But if that happens the boy will revert to the Jewish people, and new colonists will be settled on it."

That is, if Erez Israel itself lasts so long. The chances that it will do so seem to be about even. On the one hand, it is being planted intelligently and shows every sign of developing in a healthy manner. But on the other hand there are the Arabs—and across the Jordan is a vast reservoir of them, all hungry, all full of enlightened self-interest. Let some catastrophe in world politics take the "ritish cops away, and the Jews will be there to take the many lovely farms will have to fight desperately for their property and their lives.

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# State Dep't on Record Opposing Foreign Controversies in U. S.

## Case of Italian War Vets in 1931 Cited by Kohler; Boycott Against Reich Is Not Violation of Law, Lawyer Points Out, Citing a Precedent

Max J. Kohler, writer of the following article, is a noted New York lawyer and an authority on immigration law. He is a former assistant U. S. District Attorney in New York. He is a member of the Executive Committee of the American Jewish Committee and a representative of B'nai B'rith on the Joint Council on German Jewish

In this concluding article he discusses the legal aspects of the Nazi propaganda situation in this country and urges that vigorous measures be taken against those who violate our national laws by the dissemination of propaganda creating racial hatred.

He also outlines previous cases and legal measures taken to prevent the influence and racial bias through various organizations and individuals.

**A recent Kentucky decision entitled West vs. Commonwealth 735 is of particular interest in this connection. In it, Kentucky's Supreme Court reviewed the evidence in a prosecution on a "branch of the peace" for participation in a Ku Klux Klan demonstration and a verdict of conviction justified by the evidence. In it, the chief of police of Somerset, Kentucky, was brought before a grand jury and convicted on this charge. A masked parade of Ku Klux Klanners had been publicly arranged for, and forbidden by the appropriate authorities, and warrants were sworn out for the arrest of ring-leaders, should the parade nevertheless take place, which were placed in the defendant's hands. Instead of serving the warrant when the parade took place, he rode at the head of the procession, which bore a banner with the legend, "Who says we cannot march?" He was thereupon indicted, though alone of all the participants. Unfortunately, he was brought before a grand jury who had previously expressed his prejudices and bias against him, and who insisted on presiding at the trial, though challenged for this reason by the Kentucky statute. For this technicality, the appellate court reversed, but ordered a new trial on an opinion which ought to be considered as to his being convicted anew.**

At present, legislative investigations are being conducted into such un-American racial and religious propaganda, imported from foreign lands. The preliminary report of the Dickstein Sub-Committee of the U. S. House of Representatives Committee on Immigration and Naturalization, produced by aliens in the United States," led to the appointment of a new committee with broad powers, to investigate and report on the propriety of prohibiting such propaganda was vigorously expressed in the National Democratic Platform of 1916, on which Woodrow Wilson was elected during the Great War, but before our entry into it, with the following plank:

"There is gathered here in America the best of the world in the industry and the genius of the whole world, the elements of a great race and a magnificent society to be welded into a mighty nation. Whoever, actuated by the purpose to promote the interest of a foreign power, in disregard of our own country's welfare or to injure this government in any

foreign relations or cripple or destroy its industries at home, and whoever, by arousing prejudices of a racial, religious or ethnic nature, create racial animosities among our people, or obstruct the wholesome process of unification, is faithless to the trust which the privileges of citizenship impose in him and is disloyal to his country. We therefore condemn as subversive to this Nation's unity and integrity, and as destructive of its welfare, the activities of every group or organization, political or otherwise, that has for its object the advancement of the interest of a foreign power, whether such object is promoted by intimidating the government, a political party or representatives of the people, or which is calculated and tends to divide our people into antagonistic groups, and thus to destroy the complete agreement and solidarity of the people and that unity of sentiment and purpose so essential to the perpetuity of the Nation and its free institutions." (Party National Party Platform, p. 376.)

**Foreign Controversies Here**  
Our State Department on March 28, 1931, went on record in vigorous opposition to such efforts to transfer to our courts legal differences arising from purely political controversies abroad. The occasion was receipt by President Hoover of a resolution adopted at a meeting of Italian veterans held in this city on February 15, 1931, passed at a mass meeting in which interferences in American affairs had been discussed by the Italian Ambassador. The resolutions had been transmitted to the President by Dr. Charles Fama of this city, but the State Department expressed its disapproval in a letter to him as follows:

"Sir: By reference from the White House I acknowledge receipt of the resolutions passed at a mass meeting of Italian war veterans held at Irving Plaza Hall, in the City of New York, on Feb. 15, 1931, and in which you participated through the good offices of Senator Copeland.

The resolutions have received due consideration by the appropriate officers of this Government, who have reached the decision that the Royal Italian Ambassador at this capital is not involved in the national controversies among American citizens of Italian origin described therein, and that no action by this Government is indicated in respect thereto.

This Government, as you are undoubtedly aware, has no interest in controversies arising within groups of American citizens of foreign origin, and in questions of internal politics in the countries to which they formerly owed allegiance. It recognizes, however, the feeling of all true American citizens, and in view of the day when such groups will become so thoroughly identified with the country of their adoption, that they will cease to engage in futile controversies of that nature. I feel confident that you, and the other gentlemen who signed the resolutions, will join me in the hope that that day will not be too long delayed, and that you will exert your influence to that end among the American citizens of Italian origin. "I'm terribly sorry. Your scenario will do for Austria, but your grandmother doesn't suit Berlin."

sort to the boycott was initiated practically officially by the Nazi government when the anti-Jewish boycott of April 1, 1933, was ordered in Germany in alleged resentment of our natural, proper and justifiable publicly proclaimed indignation at Germany's "setting the clock back" and resorting to assaults on civilization not heard of in an allegedly civilized country since the Middle Ages. Naturally, this German boycott and the outrageous persecutions of which it was an incident, in time gave rise in our own country to a boycott of Germany, participated in by some American Jews and their sympathizers, and by the American Federation of Labor as a unit. The shrewdness of the claim that we in this country have no right to concern ourselves with such barbaric medieval persecutions and discriminations as the Nazi regime is resorting to abroad, I have expressed at length in my pamphlet "The United States and German Jewish Persecutions - Precedents for Popular and Governmental Action." (New York, England, France and Holland and other civilized countries have publicly expressed similar indignation, popular and often governmental, and also the League of Nations officially.

In that pamphlet I showed, moreover, that Germany was thereby directly violating an express international obligation assumed by the Peace Conference to the United States and the other Allies, to treat her Jewish and other minorities exactly on the basis of the same equal rights she accorded to her Christian "Aryan" inhabitants. This purely retaliatory boycott—organized in reprisal of an anti-Semitic movement—is not a violation of our law nor direct adjudged by our New York Court of Appeals in the closely analogous case of Pease ex rel Burnham vs. Flynn, 139 N. Y. 180. In the same case, the defendant Burnham and other Jewish theatrical proprietors were prosecuted for an alleged unlawful conspiracy for jointly arranging to exclude one James S. Metcalfe from their theatres, and thus "boycotting" him, because Metcalfe had for years published vicious attacks upon them in theatrical reviews, which the court which contained (to quote the Court) "malicious, vile and unjustifiable attacks upon those of the Jewish race."

A city magistrate found Burnham guilty and sentenced him to imprisonment, whereupon he instituted habeas corpus proceedings to secure his release. The Supreme Court at special term decided the habeas corpus proceedings against him, but the Appellate Division reversed, ordering his discharge, in an opinion reported in the Consolidated Edition 578. On appeal to the Court of Appeals, that Court also unanimously ordered defendant Burnham's release. It reversed the action of the City Magistrate. In the opinion written for the court by Judge Edward T. Bartlett, he said at p. 185:

contradicted avowal of the motive that led the managers to protest themselves from public articles reflecting on their personal integrity and a protest against unjustifiable attacks upon their patrons and members of the Jewish faith. It would be quite out of place, owing to its character, to quote from an article (Exhibit A) written, signed and admitted by Metcalfe as genuine, and introduced in evidence by the relator, which is, to speak with moderation, an unexampled illustration of raw bitterness and hatred. A dramatic critic indulging in such intemperate language may reasonably expect to arouse unpleasant antagonisms.

Moreover, such course on the part of temporary visitors, not even admitted for permanent residence, is all the more flagrant and objectionable.

An able article recently published in the American Journal of International Law entitled "The National Boycott as an International Delinquency" by C. L. Bouve, p. 19, et seq. shows that

where an international boycott is involved, directed against persons in another country, much greater leeway is permitted to the organizers of such boycott than where one merely involving people within a state or country is concerned.

The important question suggests itself whether our prosecuting officials will not promptly take their duty and prosecute the Nazi conduct and violations of fundamental principles of civilized life on our own shores. So far, they have contented themselves merely with dealing with a few minor offenders who were presumably guilty merely of disorderly conduct in connection with their recruitment of illegal combinations and conspiracies of the Nazi mass meeting and the ties hatched on" announced there.

P. S. Since the above was written, I read with deep interest in The Jewish Daily Bulletin of Tuesday the 17th instant that one Charles W. LaCroz of Jersey City was sentenced to ninety days for pasting anti-Semitic post-ers on a summer school in that city. He admitted that he was a member of the "Silver Shirts," and said that there was not enough "action" for him on the "Friends of New Germany." The stickers which he pasted in shop windows originally came from Germany and urged Christians to patronize only Christian doctors and lawyers, to demand Christian entertainment on the stage and radio, and to protest against Jewish judges. This is a concrete illustration of the claim I make above that Nazi anti-Jewish activities in this country are a violation of our criminal laws.

## Friendship Tours Offers Trip To Soviet, Including Study

A variety of tours of the Soviet Union are offered this season by Friendship Tours. One consists of a summer school in the First Moscow University and two weeks' travel. The Soviet Seminar is under the direction of Francis A. Henson, economic and political instructor. A group of American students are expected to take up the courses, which are to be given in English. They will sail June 30.

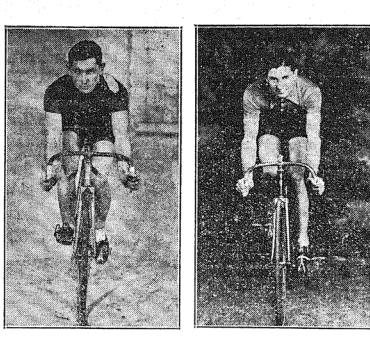
## Not Many Jews in Bike Games

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# The Bulletin's Day Book

Hitler has rolled up another victory in the underground warfare between himself and the volatile Goering. Heinrich Himmler, young and brutally efficient, one of Hitler's most dependable and valued allies in this conflict, has been named inspector-general of the Prussian political police of which Goering is nominally the head.

Himmler has been commander of the secret police in all the Reich states except Prussia where Goering, as premier, appointed himself police head. Perhaps Himmler's chief duty has been to get the "dirty" on all the Nazi leaders and keep tabs on them for his master. At any rate, it has been one of the most important tasks he has performed. It is reliably reported that were the contents of the special file he has assembled at Munich made public, the revelations of scandal and duplicity would far exceed anything yet charged by the most violent of anti-Nazis.

His appointment must be looked upon as a weakening of Goering's position, since, while Goering technically remains head of the Prussian secret police, the reins of power are actually in the hands of this Hitler aide. The Gestapo, hereafter, must be considered as Hitler's personal police arm.

What is constructive criticism? That is a question that is perplexing Germany's non-Nazi editors. Dr. Fyfe says Goebbels, newspaper arbiter of what German shall read, see, hear and think, finds his completely coordinated press "monotonous." In making his discovery, he is some months behind the reading public.

Having found the press monotonous because German editors, for some strange reason, prefer conformity to a dictator's rule than lies of jobs and enforced residence in concentration camps, the minister for propaganda and public enlightenment blames the newspapermen and tells them he wants "less monotony and more criticism."

The criticism, however, he warns them, must be "constructive" with the proviso that it must be supported by a "readiness to assume responsibility."

This responsibility is the rub. What editor will, for instance, criticize the esthetic judgments of Herr Doktor Goebbels? Or question the Nazi Jewish policy, or reveal the real state of affairs in Germany's foreign trade or in her employment problem? About the only thing these poor editors can criticize or attack is the Jew.

Treibsch-Lincoln, of unblowled fame has returned to the limelight after years of obscurity. He returned, not as a German spy but as a missionary seeking to convert Canadians to the joys of Buddhism.

In Asiatic costume, with two gleaming bits of jade in the long string of black beads he wore over his black robes, and a black skull cap on his shaven head, he told newspapermen at Vancouver, "I had wiped out the past."

But that is something easier said than accomplished and the pious abbott, Chao-King, remains to most people, the apostate Jew who became a Presbyterian minister and a curate in the Church of England; the Hungarian who became a British citizen; the British M. P. who became a forger and spy, German monarchist and a mysterious power behind the throne in the attempt to create a new Chinese dynasty.

The Socialist leaders have been held in the crowded Vienna prisons without charges being filed against them. None of them participated in the resistance in the concentration camp, as soon as it began. Most of them are elderly men who have occupied leading positions in the Austrian Social Democratic city administration.

(Continued from Page One) malignant anti-Semitism combined with spiritualism and assertions that offers for these actions came to him from "obscure" sources through the ether.

His Jews, President. New Deal. Most of the contents of Liberation were confined to vicious attacks on the Jews, President Roosevelt, the New Deal, the Elders of Zion, combined with preachings on the "Christ Democracy" and "evolution from an Aryan" through the ether. Most of the articles were couched in a biblical language. Pelley attacked President Roosevelt as being in "unity" with "the Jew-Roosevelt." He declared that the NRA and the entire Roosevelt administration were acting in accordance with orders from the "secret Jewish world government" and even went so far as to blame the assassination of President Lincoln and the Civil War upon the Jews.

Pelley's libelous and close cooperation with the Nazis was revealed when a note of the Silver Shirts in California, revealed against his dictatorship. Pelley published articles from the Hitlerite Deutsche Zeitung in New York and that name in turn published all of Pelley's virulent attacks on the Jews.

Hitler "Revealed" to Pelley. Pelley stated that it had been revealed to him from "divine sources" some time ago that "a young house painter in Germany would rise and clear his country of the Jews" and that this young man was one of a number of "great personalities." Pelley declared that he had been blinded to cooperate with this "hitler" and that therefore the advent of Hitler did not surprise him.

Most of Pelley's income seems to have come from wealthy society women in various parts of the country who had been interested through spiritualism and by alleged psychic manifestations in his movement.

# Request Delay In Re-Forming Rabbinate Body

## Agrudath Israel Asks Wauchop for Time to Solve Problems

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) FRANKFURT AM MAIN, April 22.—A request for a six weeks' delay before concluding negotiations regarding the reorganization of the Rabbinical Council of the Holy Land was forwarded to General Sir Arthur Wauchop, High Commissioner for Palestine, by the Executive Council of the Agudath Israel world Orthodox Jewish organization.

The cabled appeal to Gen. Wauchop states that the delay requested would give the Rabbinical Council of the Holy Land time to decide questions reaching out of Palestine.

The Palestine government has proposed that the constitution of the Keneseth Israel (Jewish Community), which provides for both lay and religious authorities, remain unchanged, but that three representatives of the Agudath be added to the Rabbinical Council, established under that constitution, and that an Agudath rabbi be added to the Chief Rabbinate.

At present there are in the Rabbinical Council six members, three of them representing the Sephardic element in the religious Jewish community of Palestine and two the Ashkenazim. In the Chief Rabbinate, which now consists of two religious leaders, one similar to the Chief Sephardim and the other the Ashkenazim.

Richard A. Moore of Brooklyn spoke on behalf of the Catholic students. Agreeing with a suggestion offered at one of the sessions, Moore explained that if he were to look at the Conference as a Yale undergraduate, the thing to do would be to put aside the living part of the problem as a purely philosophical one.

Moore also cited Professor Alan Valentine's suggestion that intolerance be reduced to its minimum in educational institutions. "The Yale man can answer this through the medium of the college plan," he said.
