Why Hitler Can't Last

Philip L. Seman, General Director of the Jewish People's Institute, of Chicago, writes me, in part, as follows: "I have just finished reading once more your editorial in The Jewish Daily Bulletin of Thursday, March 1. It was 'A Purim Forecast.'"

"In the light of what has happened in Germany during the last ten days, it occurs to me that a comment on this editorial would be timely. Of course, you do not want to set yourself up as a prophet or the son of a prophet, but I feel that you have, without any question of a doubt, as fine an insight into world politics and their machinations as the best in our field."

"I originally thought of writing an article based on your foresightfulness for the *B'nai B'rith* Magazine, but I believe that it is due you and The Jewish Daily Bulletin the first opportunity either to reprint the editorial, or write another, or refer to it in the forecast."

"I have received numerous requests for a reprint of that editorial. Since the publication of my Open Letter to Dr. Schacht in December, 1933, and my editorial, 'A Purim Forecast,' on March 1, 1934, events in Germany have confirmed my prognostication. Even the recent visit of Hitler to Mussolini was an unmistakable evidence of Hitler's desperate attempt to save himself and his power by making concessions to Hitler in the matter of the Austro-German Nazi Anschluss."

"In my forecast published more than four months ago, I presented my reasons why Hitler cannot last more than two years. Now believe that his end will come much sooner. The readers of The Jewish Daily Bulletin may be interested in rereading my analysis of the German situation and the Hitler blunders, as outlined in my editorial of March 1."

A Purim Forecast

It is often asked how long Hitlerism—the system of the modern Haman—can last. Many people believe that Hitlerism is destined to remain in power for a long time and to spread also to other lands."

"I do not share this view. I know how unwise it is to indulge in prophesies. But I am convinced that Hitlerism cannot last long, for the following reasons:

"Hitlerism came into power as a result of the agitation of demagogues who promised the defeated German people the restoration of a powerful Germany. Hitlerism promised to wipe out the humiliation of the German guilt in the World War."

"Hitlerism promised the defeated German people a new place in the sun, as an equal

Jewish Sabbath Alliance Snubs 'Concession' on School Opening

Wants Session to Start Sept. 12; Board Sets Sept. 11

What appears to be a partial concession to the recent request of the Jewish Sabbath Alliance that the Board of Education defer the opening of school in the fall from September 10 to September 12, because the Jewish New Year holy days fall on the tenth and eleventh of that month, has been granted by the school authorities.

A letter to the Alliance, signed by Dr. Harold G. Campbell, Superintendent of Schools, announces that the schools will be opened September 11. The announcement, however, is worded in an ambiguous manner which leaves room for doubt as to whether the date set is really a concession.

Introduction Into Land Will Be Punished, Premier Says

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, July 8.—Sensational revelations may be expected if implications in the speech delivered yesterday by Premier Ismet Pasha in the Turkish National Assembly regarding anti-Semitism are proven, the Daily Telegraph declared.

Referring Friday to the expulsion of Jews from the Dardanelles region, the Premier declared that "anti-Semitism is not a Turkish product. Any threat of its introduction into Turkey will be punished in a most exemplary manner."

The Turkish Minister of the Interior has initiated measures to punish the officials guilty of expelling the Jews from their homes and to protect the refugees dislodged by their action.

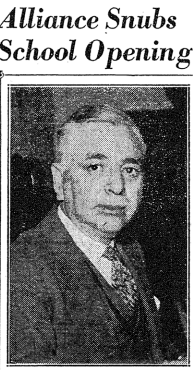

Ozet Calls to Stimulate Biro-Bidjan Migration; Builders Are Favored

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, July 8.—Ozet, Russian Jewish organization for the settlement of Jews on the land, has decided to facilitate the immigration of several hundred Polish Jewish families to Biro-Bidjan, the Moment, Warsaw Jewish daily, reported today. Building workers and technicians of all kinds will be given preference. The first group will leave for Biro-Bidjan in the spring of 1935.

The Ozet decision, the Moment declared, was made following the report of the Biro-Bidjan Jewish organization for settlement of Polish Jews in Biro-Bidjan. The group was organized in Warsaw on June 9 and immediately entered into negotiations with the Ozet in Moscow and with the Polish Foreign Office.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, July 8.—Ludwig Vogelstein and Rabbi Samuel Schulman, both of New York, were the main speakers today at the concluding session of the International Conference of the World Union for progressive Judaism.

Liberal Judaism is able to compute a 3,000-year-old tradition with the mental and spiritual requirements of the day and with the achievements of science, Vogelstein said, adding that religion stands above race because all religious people have something in common.

Rabbi Schulman asserted that the heritage of Judeo-Christian civilization will continue.

Irrington Rioting Under Quiz Today

Evidence to Be Turned Over to Grand Jury; May Call Reporters

(Special to the J.D.B.) NEWARK, July 8.—A rioting investigation into the siping that marked a Nazi meeting in Irrington on May 21 will be opened here tomorrow by Detective Clarence Merrill, case investigator, it was announced by County Prosecutor William W. Rachmoff.

Evidence collected will be turned over to the grand jury when it meets in September. It is expected that reports will be presented at the grand jury will be asked to testify.

Eleven Nazis and five anti-Nazis were arrested after the Irrington riot. They were released on \$500 bail each pending investigation and possible indictment by the grand jury in September.

Nazi Paper Demands Quiz on Their Activities

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, July 8.—No new policy regarding the Jews of Germany has not crystallized out of the developments of the past week, which resulted in the execution of at least a dozen Nazi leaders who had been responsible for many of the most vicious manifestations of Nazi anti-Semitic policy and in a new realignment of political force within the Reich.

For the moment the Jewish question, which had been of considerable importance because of its reactions on Germany's foreign trade, has been overshadowed by the major questions of the day and the struggle for control of the Reich between the conservative elements and the radical Nazi wing.

One of these major questions, concerning the relations of Germany with the outside world, was brought sharply to the fore in a sensational speech by Rudolf Hess, Chancellor Hitler's "second self," in which he pleaded for an understanding with France, warned against impending war and dared opposition to tion to cross the Reich's frontiers.

While this speech attracted more attention than any of development of the day, the Jews have not been completely forgotten.

Amsterdam Rioters Raid Jewish Shops

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) AMSTERDAM, July 8.—Jewish storekeepers were among the victims in the Communist riots here when several were killed and scores injured in a demonstration against the reduction of the unemployment dole.

The rioting, which took place in many parts of the city, spread into the Jewish quarter. At its height, some of the rioters turned and looted the shops abutting the streets on which they were fighting the police. Many of the shops were completely pillaged.

Adjusting Lives

As a result of the lower birth rate and curtailed immigration the aging of the American population has gone forward with great speed in the past fifty years. For the first time in our history, in the years from 1929 to 1930, the white population under five years of age decreased and the number of children in the group below that age was less than those between six and ten, while at the same time the increase in the number of elders was larger than ever before.

The last decennial census (1930) shows that the number of persons from forty-five to sixty-four years old has increased by one-fourth since 1920 and the number of those from sixty-five to seventy-four years old by over one-third. It might almost be said that the older the group, the more rapid its gain in numbers. Still greater are the changes in the foreign-born group, among whom the Jews form not less than ten per cent.

DR. FRANK has analyzed and measured, disclose the age composition of the foreign-born whites as a whole in 1930. Fifteen years hence, it has thus been estimated, about twenty-six per cent of all the foreign-born whites will be found in the group of sixty-five years and over, whereas in 1930 only twelve per cent and in 1910 not more than nine per cent.

It follows that in 1950 one out of every four foreign-born Jews will be sixty-five years or over, while only twenty-five per cent of them will be from twenty to forty-four, and the majority of the remaining fifty per cent will be middle-aged persons (forty-five to sixty-six).

The 80,000 Jewish immigrants in the years since July 1, 1924, a great many were elderly persons—parents coming to join their children in America. This is an additional factor in the rapid increase of elders among foreign-born Jews, who form about forty per cent of the entire American Jewish community.

The total number of foreign-born Jews was assumed unchanged from 1920 to 1930. Taking in account, however, the age distribution, we find that in each age period up to and including thirty-five to thirty-nine years old, the number of foreign-born has decreased since 1920. This decrease of persons under the age of forty resulted in a much greater concentration in older age periods within the foreign-born Jewish community (the bulk of which consists of men and women over forty) than occurred either among the Jewish community in America as a whole or the native white population at large.

The foreign-born group, which now forms one-tenth of the nation, is maintained by immigration. At present, however, the immigration policy and economic conditions to which are holding the number of immigrants at a very low level. In the pre-war period, on the other hand, the influx of newcomers was constant and heavy, and about two-thirds of them were undoubtedly elderly, with only ten per cent of the immigrants were older than forty-five years.

Causes of Age Trends

The population in the older group of the foreign-born Jews can now continue to show great gains in numbers for several years. This results from the large immigration that took place in the ten years before the World War, when the great majority of the Jewish newcomers were men and women between twenty and thirty years of age.

The numerical changes in the foreign-born age groups, namely, the increase of the number of the number of immigrant Jews under forty and the steady growth in numbers of the middle-aged, will be a bold feature in the makeup of the American-Jewish community. Still greater will be the change reflected in the increasingly elderly character of the older groups in relation to the number of the foreign born Jews as a whole. Here is an example.

Kosher Group Asked to Join Poultry Strike

Public Welfare Is Cited in Request for United Action

Wholesale and retail poultry dealers, now on strike against a trucking and coop hire monopoly, are seeking the cooperation of the Federation of Kosher Butchers of Greater New York, whom they have asked to join them in a sympathy shut-out.

At a conference between representatives of both groups, the poultry men argued that simultaneous action would be in the interests of New York's 5,000 kosher butchers and the general public, since it would eliminate many trade shibes and would result in lower prices to retail meat dealers and to consumers.

The Federation board of directors now has the question under consideration. Officials of the butchers' organization pointed out, however, that if poultry men and meat dealers were to be on strike at the same time, the kosher-buying public would find itself deprived of both meat and poultry.

The Federation also is faced with additional problems. Some time ago it decided to boycott the "Big Four" packing houses in protest against their raising of meat prices. This boycott was held in abeyance pending the outcome of a hearing in Washington last week relative to the kosher butchers' request for a separate NEA code.

Action on the boycott now awaits the decision of General Johnson and his aides, and it is expected that the strike at this time might complicate these other matters.

Central America Welcomes Jews

Little Discrimination Found by Dr. Coranik in That Region

No official anti-Semitism, little discrimination and a generally liberal government policies in Mexico, Guatemala and Honduras were reported by Dr. Abraham Coranik, recently returned from a tour of investigation for three Jewish immigrant societies, in an interview.

Dr. Coranik, editorial writer for "The Jewish Daily Bulletin" and Central America by the HIAS, the ICA and the Emigré, the Jewish immigrant aid societies of New York, London and Paris respectively, to investigate possibilities for settlement by German-Jewish refugees.

Mexico, Guatemala and Honduras would welcome several thousand workers whose efforts could aid materially in the development of these countries, Dr. Coranik asserted, but it should be clearly understood that a large immigration under the present conditions of the world market is absolutely impossible. It would not be permitted by the respective governments."

"Selected Immigration"

"On the other hand," he pointed out, "to select immigrants of qualified people such as skilled artisans, agriculturists or industrialists could be effected after proper negotiation."

Dr. Coranik ascribed anti-Semitic agitation in Mexico to "the agitation of a certain group of orthodox and promoters who were incensed by the condition of newly-arrived Jews with their more modern business methods, in addition, the Nazis allied themselves with certain political groups among the Mexicans and tried to make trouble for the Jews."

"The enlightened intellectual class," he said, "understands and opposes anti-Semitic discrimination and

the racial question are not applicable to those countries in which there already exists a great problem between the Indians and the Whites."

The Jewish problem does not exist in Guatemala, Dr. Coranik declared, and the government suppresses Nazism, which is represented by wealthy German plantation owners.

Dr. Coranik's research in Honduras was incomplete because of the hurricane, which broke out while he was in Tegucigalpa, the capital.

Voorhis, secretary of the university, announced.

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Mogil Talks to Graduates

Dr. Isidor Mogil of the board of directors of the National Hebrew School, pointed out at the annual graduation of that institution the important role which it is playing in the Jewish upbringing of the American youth. The thirty-four graduates of the elementary and high school courses, he said, were now installed with a religious and civic spirit.

Dr. Solomon Neumann, vice-president of the school made an appeal for funds for the organization which is now celebrating its twenty-fifth anniversary.

Wauchope Gives Message Of Condolence to Widow

VIENNA, July 8.—Messages of condolence from all corners of the world continue to pour into Vienna, where Bialik's widow and daughter are, and where honors will be accorded the dead poet on Monday before his body is placed in a train for Trieste. From Trieste the body will be taken to Palestine for a national Jewish funeral and final interment in a Tel Aviv cemetery near the grave of Achad Haam.

Among the messages received here was one from Sir Arthur Gifford, Wauchope, High Commissioner of Palestine, who said: "Please accept my deepest sympathy in your bereavement. The untimely death of your husband has inflicted a grievous loss upon the Jewish people and deprived Hebrew literature of a man of letters whose genius largely contributed to the Hebrew revival of modern times."

Telegrams came from organizations, individuals, institutions and Jewish bodies of all kinds. Among them were the Central Labor Federation of Palestine, the Palestine Jewish Farmers' Association, the Jewish Agency for Palestine, the Zionist Executive in Jerusalem, the municipality of Tel Aviv and several publishing houses.

Bialik's widow declared she did not want speeches during the funeral, but only the traditional Jewish ceremony.

Revisionist Paper Supports Peace Plan

Colony to Be Named After Noted Poet

 JERUSALEM, July 8.—A new quarter of 100 houses for German Jewish refugee settlers in the Herta Bay colony of the Jewish National Fund is to be named Kriat Bialik in honor of the dead Hebrew poet laureate, it was announced today. The cornerstone of the new town is to be laid shortly. Some \$40,000 will be invested in the project, half to be supplied by South African Jewry and half by the settlers.

Death of Beiliss Recalls Tragic Ritual Trial of 1911

Funeral services for Mendel Beiliss, the Kiev brickyard superintendent who in 1911 was tried and acquitted, after a sensational, world-famous trial, of an alleged ritually murdered charge, and who late Saturday afternoon died at Saratoga Springs at the age of sixty-three, will be held at two o'clock this afternoon from the Zion Memorial Chapel, 11 Canal street. Burial will be at the Mount Carmel Cemetery, Cypress Hills.

Beiliss, who came to this country in 1871, ten years after the trial, had since been supporting himself in various ways. Chiefly, members of his family at his home, 107 Elliot Place, the Bronx, said, had been a life insurance salesman. For the last five years he had been suffering from cardiac and kidney ailments, for which he had been taking the mineral water cure at a Saratoga Springs resort. The immediate cause of his death, it was announced, was pulmonary edema and acute dilation of the heart.

The case that brought Beiliss into the world spotlight developed out of the discovery in a small grave in Kiev of the mutilated body of Andrew Yushinsky, a small Christian boy. Forty-seven knife wounds were found in his

back, behind which his hands had been bound by the murderer.

An acutely anti-Semitic state of mind, prominent in the Kiev case as well as in other parts of Russia at that time, immediately prompted a revival of an age old and sporadically recurrent "ritual murder" myth, to the effect that the boy had been killed so that his blood could be used in the preparation of Passover matzo.

Except for the fact that the Russian government at the time was facing a crisis, the Beiliss case might never have developed.

About a month before the murder was discovered the Duma had evidenced a desire to abolish the Jewish pale and give the Jews the right to enter any Russian city. In this attitude the government saw a somewhat revolutionary trend that had to be checked. It seized on the "ritual murder" charge against the Jews to keep the Duma from executing the change in the "pale" laws and all it allowed to have pushed the arrest and trial of Beiliss with all its power.

Against Beiliss himself there was not a shred of evidence. The Kiev Chief of Police, indeed, resigned his position in protest against the government's arrest of Beiliss over his head. He was convinced, he said, that the murderer had been committed by a notorious woman of the section and her gang in retaliation for the boy's activities in bearing tales to the police about their pretensions. The only apparent reason for Beiliss' connection with the case was that he lived near the scene of the crime's discovery.

"The trial brought newspaper correspondents from all over the world to report its progress for the press. At the trial the government's witnesses, including Kiev University professor and a priest, completely failed to establish a case for the prosecution.

Beiliss' lawyer, backed by many of the city's residents and the evidence of the police themselves, proved to the satisfaction of the presiding judge, Goldfritz, that the accused could not possibly have committed the crime of which he was accused and he was acquitted.

Beiliss is survived by his widow, Esther; two sons, Teddy and David; and two daughters, Mary and Ray. Members of the family

yesterday pointed out that Beiliss often became embroiled in arguments with friends of the family because he had consistently refused to capitalize on the reputation he had made from the trial.

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United Jewish Appeal Raises \$1,554,256

Warburg Announces Sum as Cities Hasten to Reach Quotas

More than \$1,500,000 has already been raised by the Jews of America for their persecuted and stricken co-religionists in Nazi Germany, Felix M. Warburg, national chairman of the United Jewish Appeal, announced yesterday.

The announcement was the first report since the campaign of the United Jewish Appeal was launched last March. The quota set for the United States is \$3,000,000. The drive is being conducted under the auspices of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee and the Jewish Palestine Campaign.

Mr. Warburg said the exact total obtained to date is \$1,554,256. Of this amount the largest share, \$704,000, came from New York City. Thru Thursday forty-one countries in forty-four states participated in the fund-raising efforts.

Additional campaigns are scheduled in at least 200 other cities, including Chicago, Cincinnati, Baltimore, Denver, Louisville, Buffalo, Atlanta, New Orleans, Milwaukee, St. Paul, Tulsa, Oklahoma City, Rochester, Wilkes-Barre and Des Moines, N. W. Warburg declared.

Philadelphia has come through with \$100,000 to take a position second only to New York, and Pittsburgh stands third with \$100,000. Of this latter sum a small part is to be distributed among local charities.

In making public the sums raised, Mr. Warburg issued a statement in which he declared that "our call to the Jews of America has not been in vain."

"We knew that it would not be," he declared. "We were confident that, as of old, the Jews of America would say: 'We will do — we will heed!'"

Speaking for the officers of the United Jewish Appeal, Mr. Warburg expressed "grateful appreciation" for the contributions, assuring that they were "greatly heartening."

Hebrew Union Summer School Resumes Today

Cincinnati Courses Will Be Tuition-Free to Students

(Special to the J.D.B.)
CINCINNATI, July 8.—The Hebrew Union College Summer School, which resumed tomorrow with the graduate rabbinical school and the teachers' institute as its two departments. The school was abandoned last summer because of insufficient finances.

Sessions will be held every morning from Monday to Friday inclusive over a period of five weeks, concluding on August 17.

Present indications are that the rabbinical school will not be attended as well as in previous years and that the teachers' institute will have a better than average enrollment. Tuition in both departments is free. Facilities of the dormitory are placed at the disposal of out of town students at nominal rates.

Members of the summer school faculty and their subjects are: Dr. Henry Englander, homiletics and Midrash; Dr. Jacob R. Marcus, Jewish history; Dr. Samuel S. Cohen, Jewish theology; and Professor Abraham N. Fraumbau, acting director of the summer school, Jewish religious education.

The graduate rabbinical school curriculum includes: Medieval Bible and Rabbinical readings; study of the commentaries of Rashi, Ibn Ezra and Radak and the Targumim and Massorah; (Dr. Englander); history, seminar, a critical and comparative study of the literary sources of modern and ancient Judaism; (Dr. Marcus); theology, a study of Hasidism (Dr. Cohen); and education, including curriculum construction (Dr. Fraumbau).

For the teachers' institute the study of study comprises: The Bible and its history; the conquest of Canada to the destruction of the first temple, 586 B. C. E. Conservative Rabbis Took Radical Stand at Tannersville

TANNERSVILLE, N. Y., July 8.—"We in Tannersville will go further than they did in Wernersville," the sentence doesn't apply to a bus or train or pleasure jaunt. It merely epitomizes the expression of a state of mind extant to a considerable degree at the three-day convention of the Rabbinical Assembly of the Jewish Theological Seminary at Tannersville.

Whether these conservative rabbis really did go further than their reform colleagues in the stand on social justice taken by the latter's convention in Wernersville, Pa., is problematical because the theme of the desired social program—the call for socialization of basic instruments such as banking and credit, transportation, utilities, etc., is virtually the same.

But Tannersville certainly went as far as Wernersville, and that is epochal. No such pronouncement for recreating the social order and maintaining peace has ever been given to the Assembly before. And their statements debunking "rugged individualism" would make some of Norman Thomas' speeches look mild.

Active Members Young
To those in this connection, it wasn't difficult to comprehend this most of the active members are young men, many of whom apparently are not in the ranks along social and economic lines, limiting their conservatism to the traditional theological dogmas which they regard as sacred. One question could even fit easily into the radical sphere and one or two were even "kidded" by their colleagues who hailed them as "Comrades."

But jump at no immediate conclusion: there are ultra-conservatives in the ranks, too. Remem-

ber that the Social Justice Committee report was adopted by majority vote, not unanimous vote. It might, therefore be better to strike a balance and call it a predominantly liberal convention. Self-Named U. S. Fascist Chief Has His Points, McGrady Admits

To understand the complex maneuvers of George W. Christians, president of the Crusaders for Economic Liberty, commander in chief of the Crusader White Shirts and leader of the "American Fascists and the American Reds," it is well to know something of his background.

He is about forty years old, married, and has a son about ten years old. He comes from New York where he gained his education as an engineer at the Brooklyn Polytechnic Institute.

His residence in the "national capital" at Chattanooga has completely southernized the gentleman. He has attained a Dixie accent that excels that of a majority of native sons of Tennessee. 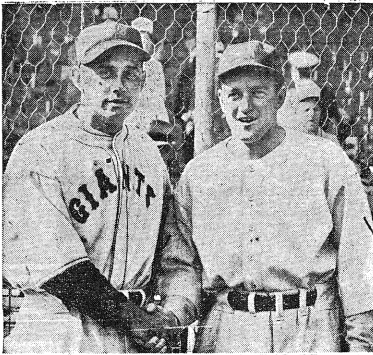

Death Claims Buenos Aires Yiddish Actor

Bernardo Weisman Was Founder of City's Jewish Stage

(U.T.A. Special Correspondence) BUENOS AIRES, June 30.—Bernardo Weisman, sixty-year actor and founder of the Yiddish theatre in this city, died here after a long illness.

Weisman was born in Bucharest. His parents were orthodox Jews and the boy was for some time an assistant to various cantors. When he became an actor Weisman toured Rumania, Turkey, Egypt and other countries with Morris Morcovitch, Fineman and other well known showmen.

In 1901 Weisman came to the Argentine and immediately set about organizing a theatre troupe. Most of the actors were amateurs.

Later Weisman succeeded in interesting a number of wealthy persons in his work and these aided him in bringing accomplished players to Buenos Aires. For twenty-eight years Weisman served the Jewish theatre as actor and director.

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The Jews of Germany

Volksrecht Editor Says ReichLacks Government In Usual Sense of Word

The struggle in Germany has only begun, according to Dr. Siegfried Lipschitz, editor of the New Yorker Volkszeitung, who spoke Saturday evening over Station WEVD. Dr. Lipschitz was formerly American representative of the German Social-Democratic service.

"Those who speak of a German government should beware," said Lipschitz. "There is no government in the universally accepted sense. The economic basis has deviated to almost nothing. Grumbles are heard everywhere. The middle-class is discouraged and rapidly disintegrating. The tension has become too great. It is sickening and almost unbelievable spectacle."

Sees Young Reich Jews Determined

Pauline Baerwald Tells B'nai B'rith Youth Party They Face Future Undaunted

(Special to the J.D.B.)—Jewish youth in Germany is facing the future determined to readjust itself as a result of conditions inimical to its life. Pauline Baerwald, junior division chairman of the American Joint Distribution Committee, declared before the opening sessions of the eleventh annual international convention of Aleph Zadik Aleph, youth branch of B'nai B'rith.

More than 500 delegates from 150 cities in the United States and Canada heard Miss Baerwald declare that the young Jews in Germany as she saw them recently.

Beware of Jews, Nazis Warn U. S.

Munich Paper Is Surprised Americans Are Not Aware of Jewish 'Menace'

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) MUNICH, July 8.—Surprise at the failure of American public opinion to awaken to the "menace" of the Jewish question in the United States was expressed by the German daily newspaper, Deutschland's Erneuerung, in a leading article viciously attacking Professor Raymond May for having written in his magazine yesterday a series of articles on "Hitlerism Invades America."

The Nazi paper asserted that Professor May was a Jew, and insinuated and pointed out that "President Roosevelt's closest coworkers are Jews, including Felix M. Warshawsky, Samuel Goldenshwan and Maurice Karp." According to the magazine "only the Jews are responsible for the anti-German feeling in the United States. Actually the Jews are leading America straight towards Communism."

American Jews were warned by the Nazi paper, however, to beware "not only of the few hundred German Nazis in America, but of the 15,000,000 Americans organized in the Silver Shirts."

Youth Chided by Blumenfeld As 'Ruthless'

Rabbi Tells Judeans at Cincinnati It Needs 'Guidance'

(Special to the J.D.B.)—CINCINNATI, July 8.—Re-valuation of the function that youth is to perform in society in general, and Judaism in particular, is an essential part of present-day Jewish life, Rabbi Samuel Blumenfeld, director of Jewish youth activity in Chicago and honorary president of Avukah, declared today in an address at the national convention of Young Judeas.

"We made a fetish of youth in the past," Rabbi Blumenfeld declared. "Recent events in European countries have shown youth to be ruthless, to be of such a gruesome and disposition that we might as well understand that youth, even as a child, needs guidance and direction, and if Zionists wish to preserve their youth they can no longer depend on their parents, sponsors and youth movements to do their task for them. It will be their task to guide and direct future generations."

The slogan of Young Judeas, Rabbi Blumenfeld said, should be "Build the Jewish Community."

David Levine, New York, president, outlined plans for increasing the membership of Young Judeas to 100,000. "The number of Jews scattered among the roster, he said, scattered among hundreds of cities in the past. The plan provides for taking in the youth departments of synagogues and temples all over the country."

(Continued from Page One) "I beg to advise you," the letter, addressed to William Rosenberg, executive secretary of the Alliance, reads, "that this matter has been very thoroughly considered by the Board of Superintendents and it is their decision that the schools should open on September 11th in accordance with the by-laws of the Board of Education." According to Mr. Rosenbergs, this is interpreted as a concession to the alliance. The by-laws of the board, he maintains, state that school opening should take place on the first Monday after Labor Day in September, which this year falls on the tenth. Further, that was the only opening announced recently by the Board. Rosenberg's opinion, which could not be verified yesterday because no member of the Board of Education could be reached is that the original by-laws were amended to take care of the contingency.

"This request is not a concession or not, however, it is unsatisfactory to the Alliance. Rosenberg informed the Jewish Daily Bulletin that the decision by the Board of Education will be formulated by Dr. Bernard Drachman, president, and Rosenberg, either today or tomorrow. Rosenberg, however, made that school opening be deferred until the twelfth of the month.

"This request is not granted, Rosenberg stated, a written appeal will be issued by the Alliance to all parents of Jewish children urging them to vote against the proposed attending school on the second day of Rosh Hashonah, as well as the first.

German Jews in Greater Panic Than Last Year, States Warsaw Report

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, July 8.—A greater state of panic prevails today among the Jews of Germany than in March, 1933, on Adolf Hitler's accession to power, the Warsaw press reports.

The Jews of Germany are in great fear that the "purging" of the storm troops will result in widespread pogroms and a recurrence of general anti-Semitic measures. The Nazi regime, however, according to the correspondents of the Warsaw press, for the moment is not exploiting the recent developments in Germany for purposes of incitement against the Jews.

Turkey Starts Inquiry; Repeatedly Refuges

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) ISTANBUL, July 8.—Minister of the Interior Shukry Bey today arrived at Adrianople to conduct an inquiry into the purpose of which is to discover the officials responsible for the recent anti-Semitic outbreaks that resulted in the expulsion of thousands of Jews from Turkish shores.

The Minister also stated the task of "repatriating those families that have been driven out; under way. A number of them have already been returned to their homes at the expense of the government. But many others are so terrorized that they fear to take advantage of the government's aid."

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WASHINGTON, July 8.—Instating that the Turkish government harbors nothing but the most cordial feelings toward the Jews living in Turkey, the Turkish Embassy in Washington today denied there was any strong anti-Semitic movement in that country. In an exclusive interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, the ambassador explained the recent outbreaks in Yugoslavia against the Jews, being in receipt of an official communication from the Turkish government giving the details.

Reveals von Schleicher Opposed Anti-Semitism

Kurt von Schleicher, former Reich's chancellor who was slain in the Hitler "purging," opposed the anti-Semitic movement disclosed today by Sir Walter Layton in the London News Chronicle. Sir Walter refers to a dinner he gave last evening, at which following Julius Streicher's anti-Jewish boycott day on April 1, 1933, during which Schleicher frantically urged the German people to adhere for the principles of liberty, to which, he stated, the nation must adhere if it wished to develop its full capacities.

Dr. Heinrich Stern, who spoke at the large German Jewish delegation, stressed his pride in the presence of the German group and pointed out that Germany was the birthplace of liberal Judaism.

Rabbi Wolff of Dresden, Germany, said in his greeting to the conference that a denial that there existed a characteristic Jewish type would be a denial of Jewish life, but making it a fetish would be against the meaning of life. He declared that Jews throughout their history had been embroiled among the peoples of the world. We affirm the historical right of the Jews to live in the land where we were born, he said, but we must not let our Jewishness be against the meaning of life.

Ignacy Rausch, Poznan city councillor and member of the Etnik anti-Semitic organization, was sentenced to a year in prison for having lauded the murderers who assassinated Colonel Pieracki, Polish Minister of the Interior, who was killed recently.

A new boycott drive, labelling all who deal with the storm troops as traitors, has gotten off to a flying start in Berlin and provincial centers.

Today the Deutsche Wochen-schau, influential Nazi publication, declaring that Germany has a shortage of raw materials and that food and clothing ration cards have already been printed, charged that this is all the fault of the Jews and demanded that Minister of Economics Kurt Schmitt use the great powers conferred upon him to regulate supplies and trade generally in an investigation of the activities of the Jews.

Provincial States Doubtful Great concern has been aroused here by reports from Prague of severe Jewish agitation in Poland and in Silesia. Strict censorship and the absence of authoritative information from the greater part of the German provinces, the Czech lands and the situation of the Jews there is by no means well known.

According to the S. S. officials, the attempt to blame the Jews for the explosion in the barracks, according to reliable reports reaching Prague, were found in the faces and temples of the victims. This statement was held to be untrue.

A grave scarcity of food, for which the Deutsche Wochen-schau has accused the Jews, has already seriously disturbing the population of the larger communities.

Even in Berlin, the capital, long queues are assembled outside the food shops to buy the meagre rations. The supply of food is scanty and the supply grows shorter daily.

The city was also agitated by reports that the storm troops were planning to avenge the deaths of their leaders and with speculations on the fate of the storm troops.
