## **LIFETIME HUNTING/COMBINATION LICENSE BENEFITS**

**All Lifetime Hunting or Combination Hunt/Fish License holders are EXEMPT from purchasing the following licenses or permits:**

- Annual Hunting License
- Furbearer/Trapping License
- Oklahoma Waterfowl Stamp
- Big Game Licenses (Deer, Bear, Elk, Antelope)
- Turkey License
- Controlled Hunt Permits

## **ADDITIONAL HUNTING LICENSES REQUIRED**

**All Lifetime Hunting /Combination License holders ARE NOT EXEMPT from purchasing the following licenses or permits when applicable:**

- Land Access Permit (In Designated Areas)
- H.I.P. (Required Ages 18-64)
- Sandhill Crane Permit
- Federal Duck Stamp (Required Ages 16+)
- Federal Permits/Fees

## **LIFETIME FISHING/COMBINATION LICENSE INFO**

**All Lifetime Fishing or Combination Hunt/Fish License holders are EXEMPT from purchasing their Annual Fishing License. The Lifetime Fishing License holders ARE NOT EXEMPT from purchasing the following licenses or permits when applicable:**

- Lake Texoma (Required Ages 16-64)
- Paddlefish Permit

## **LIFETIME LICENSE INFORMATION**

Only legal residents of Oklahoma for six (6) months preceding application who intend to remain an Oklahoma Resident may obtain a Lifetime License. Lifetime License holders enjoy the benefits of the Lifetime License for as long as they live, regardless of address change or residency change. Licenses are non-transferable.

## **LIFETIME LICENSE OPTIONS**

- Resident Lifetime Combo \$1024
- Resident Lifetime Fishing \$375
- Resident Senior Citizen Combo \$60
- Resident Senior Citizen Fishing \$30
- Resident Disabled Veteran Combo (0-59% \$200 or 60-100% \$25)

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR QUALIFICATION**

All applicants are required to have an Oklahoma Driver's License or Oklahoma State Issued ID Card, which has been held for 6 months prior. Applicants under 18 may submit parent or guardian's OK Driver's License or ID. Seniors may apply in the calendar year in which they are turning 65 or older. Disabled Veterans will need to provide an Award Letter from the VA stating their combined percentage rating.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Lifetime Licenses may be obtained by mail, online, or in person at the ODWC physical address listed above. Acceptable payment methods: Cashier's Check, Personal Check, Money Order, Discover Card, MasterCard, or Visa. Replacement Hard Cards are available for \$6.00 each.
