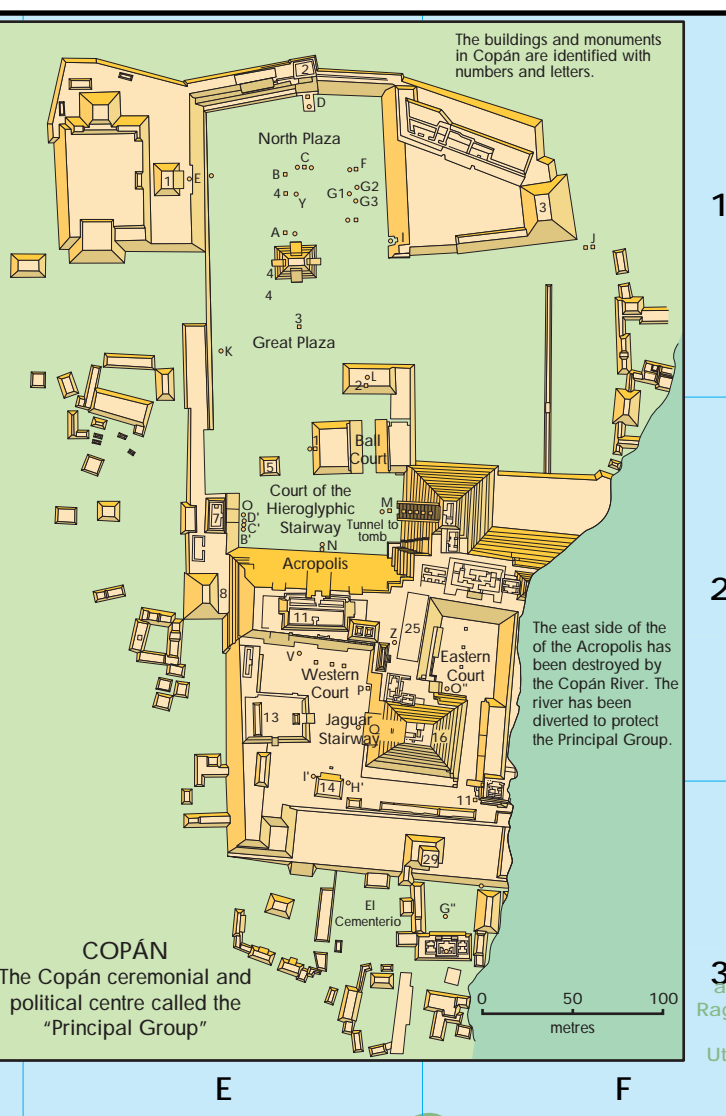

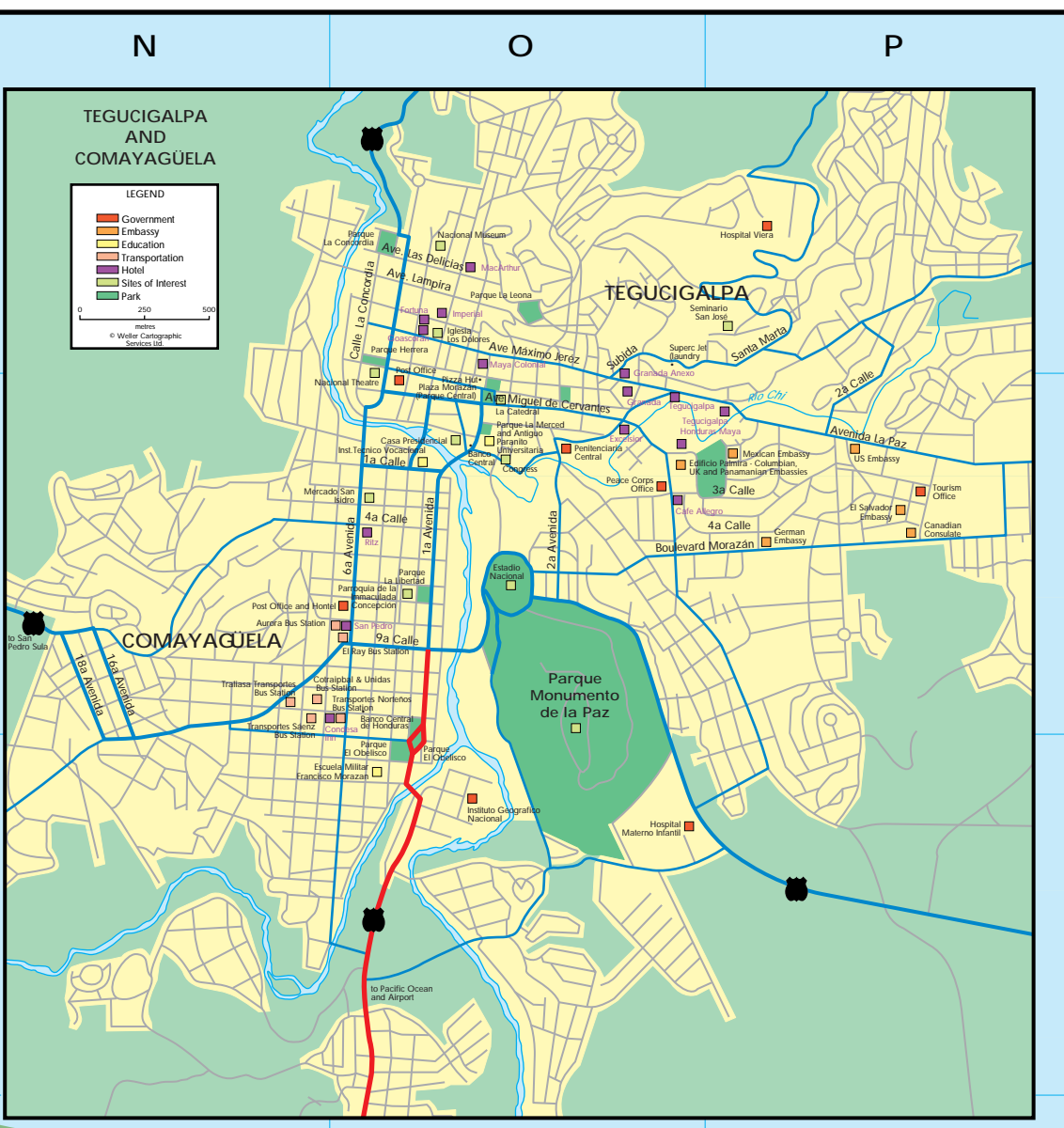


THE MAYA (AT)
