Inspired by this compelling research, the Bezos Family Foundation worked with families, scientists, community leaders, and product makers to create Vroom.

Vroom supports parents throughout their daily journey with affirming, reinforcing messages and tips. Each Vroom tip is designed to promote language development and executive function skills, and inspire "serve and return" interactions between children and the adults in their lives. Each tip is supported by a "brainy background" providing the user with the scientific "why" behind each activity. Among the many Vroom resources is a free mobile app with more than 1,000 tips.

Vroom continues to expand nationally through partnerships with household brands, entertainment channels, and by working with communities, coalitions, collective impact organizations, and states.

In Colorado, Vroom is led by the nonprofit Parent Possible.

Parent Possible actively seeks trusted organizations that are well positioned to reach parents in the course of their daily lives, sharing the science of early child brain development, making them aware of Vroom and helping apply this knowledge to their everyday lives in the form of actionable tips that detail brain building moments.

From pediatricians, home visitors and educators talking personally with parents; to museums, businesses and playgrounds creatively displaying Vroom messages and promoting the Daily Vroom free mobile app for brain building tips on the go; a wide array of organizations can share Vroom and the belief that we all have what it takes to be a brain builder!
