On August 16, 2016, we the undersigned legally constituted State Canvassing Board (hereinafter "Board") canvassed the certified copies of the County Canvassing Board Reports received from the County Auditors which report the votes cast at the August 9, 2016 State Primary Election for United States Representative, State Senator, State Representative, and State Judicial Offices, as required by Minnesota Statutes section 204C.32. We have specified in the following report the names of persons reported as receiving votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast. Based on this report, the Board makes the following declarations:

State and Federal – Partisan Offices

The Board hereby declares that the candidates in multi-county districts from each of the Republican Party, and the Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party receiving the most votes for the offices of United States Representative, State Senator, and State Representative are nominated as the candidates for the Republican Party, and Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party respectively.

Judicial – Non-Partisan Offices

The Board hereby declares that the candidates for each judicial office in multi-county districts on the state non-partisan primary ballot receiving the highest and the next highest number of votes are nominated for that office.

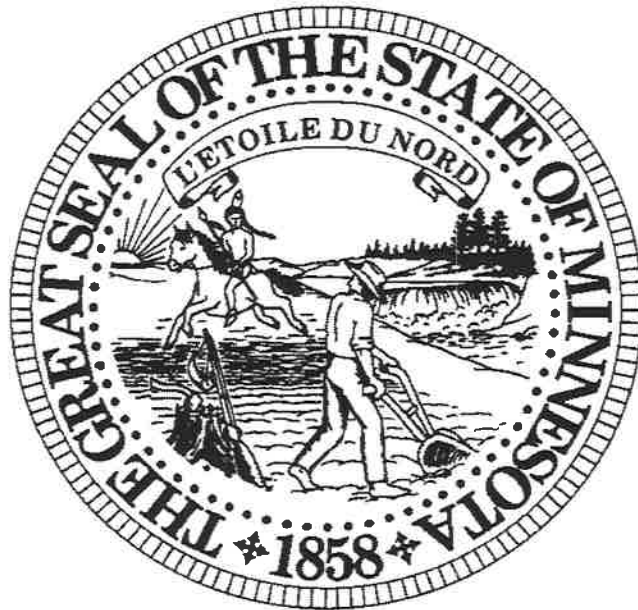
