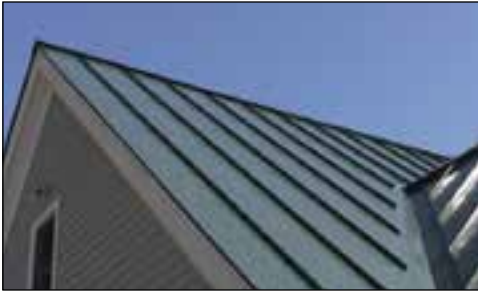

# Cabin Shells Foundation Types

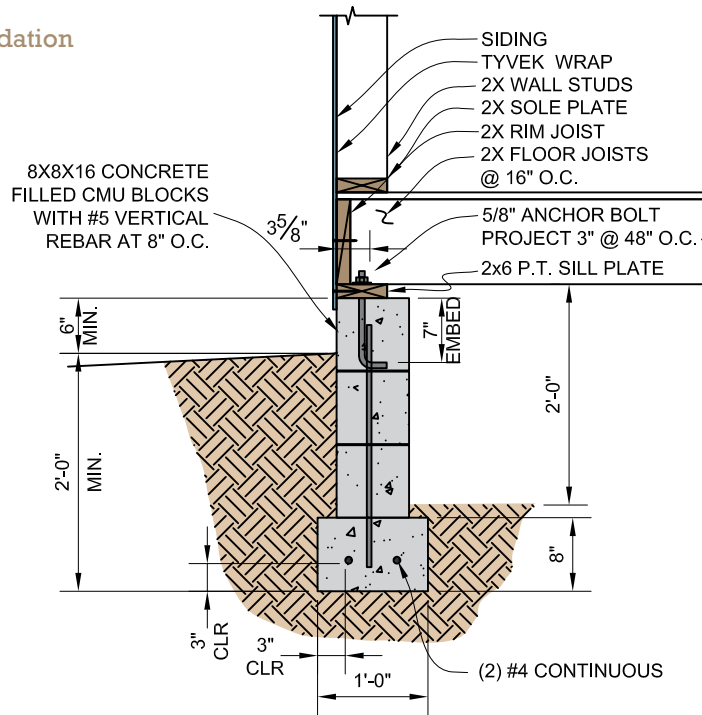

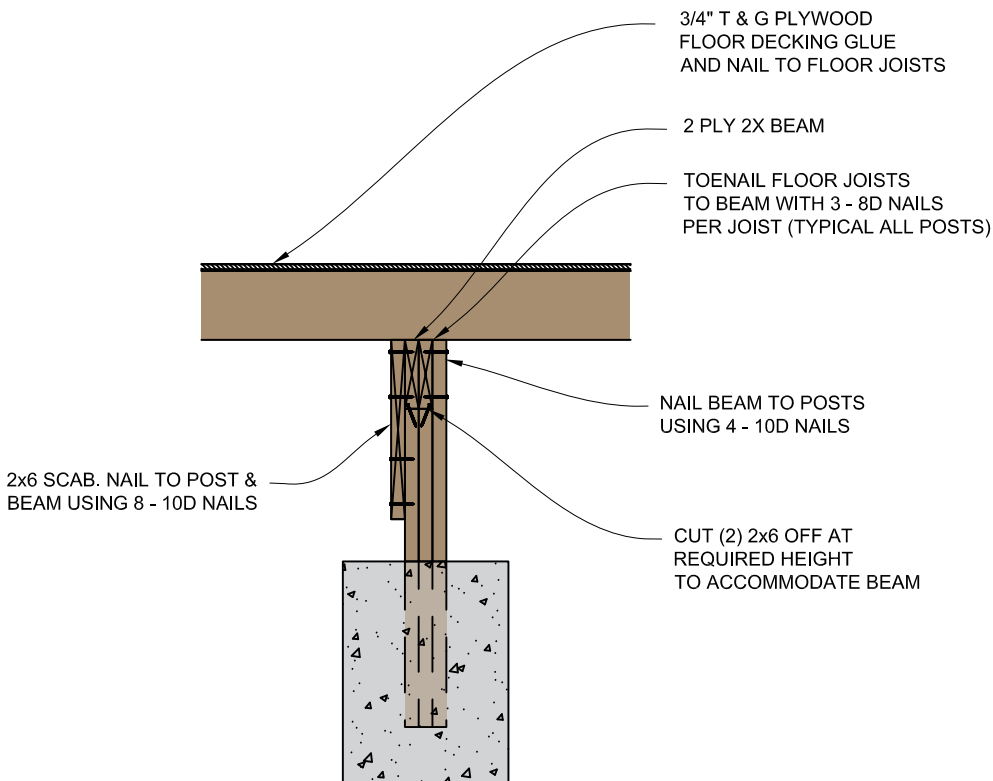
Monolithic Foundation



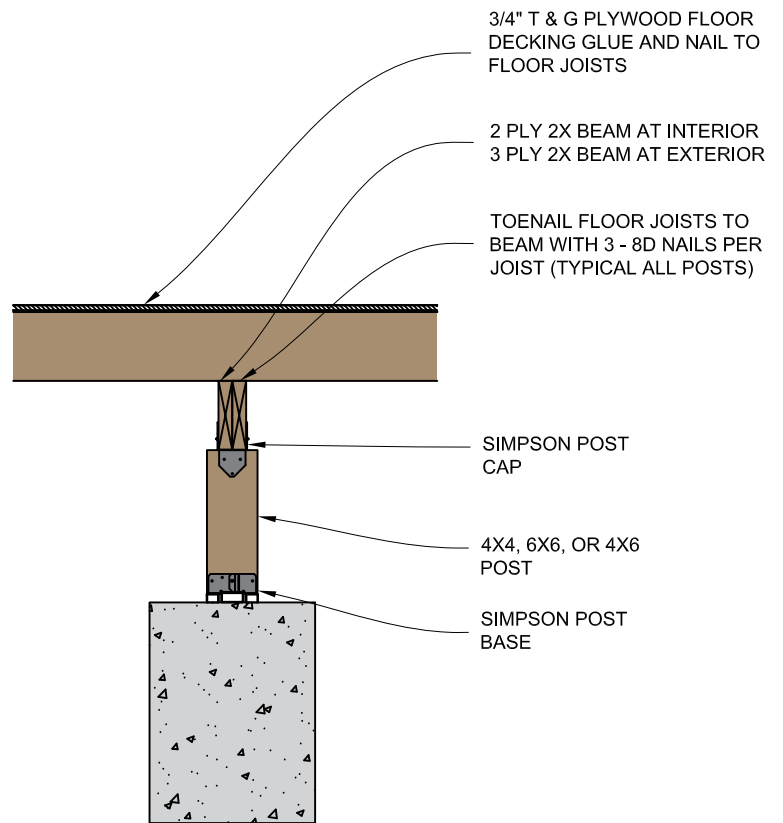
Spread-Footing Foundation
