GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation from Bishop Carroll Catholic High School requires the satisfactory completion of no less than 28 units of study in acceptable sequence.

4 credits each of religion, english, math, and science 3 credits of social studies

2 credits of a foreign language or language arts, and physical education and health .5 credits each of music or art appreciation and introduction to computer 3 credits of elective courses

Additionally, students must complete Accelerated Reader and Service requirements each year.

*Accommodations on the required number of credits will be made for upper class transfer students based on their previous school records.

Honors and advanced classes are weighted.

For the 2023-2024 school year, the average financial aid package for those who applied for aid was around \$3200, which is a 44% discount on total tuition. That number fluctuates based on need, determined by the evaluation of applications by Simple Tuition Solutions, with a range of award amounts for the current school year between \$500 and \$6500.



COLLEGE BENEFITS



BCCHS graduates with a minimum 3.0 GPA have guaranteed admittance to most programs. Guaranteed scholarships of at least \$22,000 a year for four years (\$88,000 total) with potential for more merit-based scholarships. BCCHS graduates will have weighted admittance for MBA, Nursing, OT, PT and PA programs.






MOUNT ALOYSIUS COLLEGE

Update 10-2023

BCCHS graduates are guaranteed admission with a 2.5 GPA and a S2,000 scholarship per year with a total of S8,000. Students can earn up to S72,000 in scholarships over four years and are also eligible to compete for the Mercy Presidential Scholarship worth S16,000 each year for a S64,000 total over four.

SAINT VINCENT COLLEGE







DUQUESNE UNIVERSITY

BCCHS graduates with a minimum 3.0 GPA, SAT 1080, and ACT 21 or 3.3 GPA and Test Optional are guaranteed a minimum S15,000 per year. Based on higher qualifications, students may earn up to S27,000 per year in scholarship money. BCCHS graduates are also eligible for a 10% tuition reduction per year.

FRANCISCAN UNIVERSITY

BCCHS graduates with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA who are accepted to Franciscan University and submit a FAFSA may qualify for up to a full-tuition scholarship for their freshman year. In order to maintain that scholarship for additional years, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and participate in one Catholic faith-based activity per semester.





LA ROCHE UNIVERSITY

BCCHS graduates meeting minimum requirements are eligible for, on average, S31,000 a year for four years in scholarships. Students are also eligible to apply for additional merit scholarships and residential scholarships.

GANNON UNIVERSITY

BCCHS graduates will receive a minimum \$2,000 scholarship annually for a total of \$8,000 over four years.

They are also eligible to receive merit scholarships upon acceptance as well as additional institutional aid, federal aid, and state aid.





SETON HILL UNIVERSITY

BCCHS graduates will receive a minimum S2,000 scholarship annually for a total of S8,000 over four years. They are also eligible to apply for merit based scholarships and grants.

CARLOW UNIVERSITY

BCCHS graduates are guaranteed a yearly scholarship of S5,000 for a total of S20,000 over four years.

Additionally, if a student was enrolled at BC in a college in high school class through Carlow, they are guaranteed an additional S1,000 award each year for four years for a total of S4,000.

Can I really afford an education at Bishop Carroll?

A Bishop Carroll education is more affordable than you think! Scholarships, grants, and other financial aid sources are available to our families and students. Many factors determine the amount of aid given to each family. Our goal is to make a Catholic education affordable for all who desire one!

Is faith taught consistently throughout the curriculum, and are students of all faiths accepted?

Yes and yes! Religion class is taught five days a week. In addition, students participate in a variety of Catholic services and religious activities. Students of all faiths are always accepted at BCCHS.

Are students of different ability levels accepted at BCCHS?

Yes. Bishop Carroll uses a placement test for incoming freshman to place them in a math course that fits their learning level. Assistance from the Intermediate Unit is on site at the school for reading and math assistance. An after school tutoring program has also been developed to help students maintain and improve their grades. Families of students with IEPs or other learning accommodations are asked to set up a meeting with school administrators to determine if a students needs can be met at BCCHS. In addition, several advanced and honors classes are offered. Please see page 4 of this booklet.

Is transportation provided to Bishop Carroll?

Yes. School districts that have borders within 10 miles of Bishop Carroll are required by law to provide transportation to the school. Additionally, Bishop Carroll provides transportation from the Indiana area.

Can my child attend both Bishop Carroll and Admiral Peary Vo-Tech?

Yes! Students in grades 10, 11, and 12 may choose to attend Admiral Peary Vo-Tech in a variety of programs. BC students who do attend Admiral Peary take core classes at Bishop Carroll in the morning and then attend Vo-Tech in the afternoon. Vo-Tech students pay half tuition as they are only at BC for half a day. For a complete list of all programs offered at Admiral Peary, please visit their website at https://ap.tec.pa.us/.
