

Marissa District #40 E-Learning Plan Summary

E-learning days are designed with the goal of continuing learning. E-learning days do not replace “snow days” but offer an alternative when appropriate.

In the event an e-learning day will be used District #40 Superintendent will make the call the day before an e-learning day would occur. This provides time and opportunity for teachers, students, and families to make arrangements and prepare for a successful e-learning day.

Please note, e-learning days are not “snow days.” The goal of an e-learning day is to allow learning to continue whereas a snow day halts learning for the day.

Teachers

- Take attendance each day by 9:00 AM
- Monitor email/Google Classroom/Seesaw during the day
- Assignments posted by 9:00 AM
- Teacher’s work does not exceed a total of 5 hours
- Learning may be “review” or new concepts
- Teachers will refer to Illinois Priority Learning Standards to guide learning opportunities
- Training for best practices with E-learning will take place throughout the year.

Students

- Log on and take attendance by 9:00 AM
- Complete assignments for the day and turn them in
- Communicate with teachers during the day for any support needed
- Accommodations will be made for students without access to reliable WIFI
- Students will be give a “+1” day to make up work for each E-learning day used
