<p>Friday, May 27th Final Notification of Non-Graduation</p>	<p>Seniors who have been in danger of failing required classes will be given final notification of non-graduation status.</p>
<p>Tuesday, May 31st 9:00 a.m. – West High 1:15 p.m. – Civic Auditorium Commencement Exercise</p>	<p>Commencement practice will be held on Tuesday, May 31st, at 9:00am in the West High School gym and at 1:15 pm at the Mechanics Auditorium or WHS Kilgore Stadium. Both practices are MANDATORY senior events. Students who do not attend both practices will <u>not</u> participate in the commencement ceremony. Students who attend the practice late, without prior approval, will jeopardize their right to participate in the commencement ceremony. Commencement ceremony tickets will be distributed to students during the 1:15pm practice.</p>
<p>Wednesday, June 1st 8:30 a.m. Senior Breakfast Hodel's catering</p>	<p>Students will meet in the cafeteria for a catered breakfast. Pre-sale tickets will be \$10.00 per person through May 26th and \$18 per person at the door. Seniors will receive their Freshman letter from the archives and the Panoramic Picture will be distributed.</p>
<p>Wednesday, June 1st 6:00 p.m. Commencement</p>	<p>Commencement will be held at Mechanics Bank or WHS Kilgore Stadium. Due to the size of the senior class and the seating capacity of the Auditorium, each senior will be given a maximum of 6 tickets to the Commencement ceremony. Everyone who attends must enter with a ticket, including children and infants. <u>Guests should enter before 5:50 pm or will have to wait until after the graduates march through the lobby and seated on stage before being allowed into the ceremony.</u> We encourage parents to make childcare arrangements for infants and toddlers. Students must wear business attire. No jeans or tennis/athletic shoes allowed. Graduates must be in the Mechanics Auditorium by 5:00 pm! NO exceptions! Time to be announced if held at West High's Kilgore Stadium.</p>
<p>Thursday, June 2nd 8:00-10:00 a.m. Diploma Distribution</p>	<p>Seniors will report to the Gym Foyer to receive their diploma. Seniors will be dismissed from campus after they receive their diploma.</p>
<p>Friday, June 3rd - Saturday June 4th 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 a.m. Magic Mountain Grad Nite</p>	<p>250 tickets will be on sale for the Magic Mountain Grad Nite trip at approximately \$120.00 each. This price includes transportation, buffet style dinner and admission into the park. Students should be aware that they will be assigned a bus when they pay. You must ride your assigned bus to and from this event. You will not be able to change buses. This is a package deal. You cannot drive yourself there. The Magic Mountain dress code is enforced: business casual, no logo attire allowed. Parental consent forms must be submitted when you purchase tickets from the Finance office.
