MULTI-AGE / FAMILY TEAMS

- All teams must have at least one Guardian/Parent on the team if participants are under 8 years old.
- Raffle entry for all teams!
- Artwork size: 6' x 6' (minimum) artwork space

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEAMS

- All team members must be in either 4th, 5th, or 6th grade.

- All team members must be in either 6th, 7th, or 8th grade.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- How creative the design for the artwork is.
- The best use of color as shown in the mood, light, depth, and point of view in the artwork.

During judging all participants will be asked to convene to the stage for the raffle and special musical performance.

INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES

The following is a supply list that is recommended for all participants to review and consider bringing to the event. If you have any questions, please reach out to us!



A piece of fabric or cardboard to sit or stand on to avoid smearing your work.



A soft towel, gardener's pad, or knee pads to kneel on.



Additional chalk, especially if you need a lot of a certain color. Chalk must be water soluble.



Additional Chalk colors will be provided while supplies last.



Chalk Paint: Nondrinking water, Cups, plastic baggies, small mallet, and brushes.

STRONGLY
RECOMMEND COMING
WITH PRE-CRUSHED
CHALK.



Non-drinking water and old towels or rags to clean up design and hands as necessary.



Masking tape for creating sharp borders or geometrical shapes.



A chalkboard eraser, foam, terry cloth, or shortcut brushes for blending large areas of color.



Cotton, Latex, or Nitrile gloves to protect your fingertips and assist in blending colors.



Sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat.



Bring your own Re-usable water bottle!



Canopies (10'x10' maximum), tables (4'x2' maximum) and folding chairs are permitted, BUT please remain mindful of surrounding participants and walk ways.







Food will be available for purchase, however, please feel free to pack a lunch and snacks!
