2018 House Votes

House Vote 1

H.F. 3194: Right-to-view ultrasound

Committee: Health and Human Services Reform

The right-to-view ultrasound legislation only had one committee stop in both the House and Senate, the policy committee for health and human services. In the House, this is the Health and Human Services Reform committee. Following relatively brief testimony and discussion, the bill was recommended to pass by a vote of 11-6 (pro-life win).

House Vote 2

H.F. 3194: Right-to-view ultrasound

Floor: Amendment

When the ultrasound legislation came before the full House for a vote, Rep. Laurie Halverson, DFL-Eagan, offered an amendment. The amendment would have made all aspects of Minnesota's existing Woman's Right to Know (WRTK) informed consent law optional based on the physician's subjective opinion (see Journal of the House, pg. 10362). This amendment was clearly intended to undermine WRTK, which was the underlying statute to which ultrasound was being added. MCCL opposed the Halverson amendment, which failed 48-79 (pro-life win).

House Vote 3

H.F. 3194: Right-to-view ultrasound

Floor: Passage

Following defeat of the Halverson amendment and additional discussion of the right-to-view ultrasound legislation, the bill was passed 79-48 (pro-life win).

Following passage in both the House and Senate, Gov. Mark Dayton vetoed H.F. 3194.
