Sunday, January 5, 1986

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT

NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE COLUMBUS OH

310 AM EST SUN JAN 5 1986

SNOW WAS FALLING OVER CENTRAL OHIO..AND TEMPERATURES HAVE FALLEN BELOW FREEZING.

AT 310 AM THE COLUMBUS WEATHER RADAR SHOWED SNOW OVER MOST OF CENTRAL OHIO. IT WAS BECOMING PATCHY BETWEEN COLUMBUS AND DAYTON. LESS THAN AN INCH ACCUMULATION IS EXPECTED.

HOWEVER, THE TEMPERATURE AT PORT COLUMBUS FELL FROM 34 AT 2AM TO 30 AT 3AM. THE TEMPERATURE IS EXPECTED TO FALL INTO THE MIDDLE 20S BEFORE DAYBREAK.

CENTRAL OHIO IS GOING THROUGH A WEATHER CHANGE.

RAIN THROUGH OUT THE DAY BECAME MIXED WITH SLEET JUST BEFORE 500 PM..AND NOW SNOW IS ALSO FALLING IN COLUMBUS.

THE SLEET HAS BEEN LAYING ON SECONDARY STREETS..SIDEWALKS..AND ON PARKING LOTS..MAKING SOME DRIVING AND WALKING DANGEROUS.

RAIN AND SLEET SHOULD END SOON AROUND COLUMBUS..BUT SOME SNOW WILL CONTINUE..WITH LITTLE OR NO ACCUMULATION.

720 PM EST SUN JAN 19 1986

CENTRAL OHIO CONTINUES TO SEE A MIXTURE OF PRECIPITATION.

AT 715PM AT THE PORT COLUMBUS AIRPORT..A MIXTURE OF RAIN AND SNOW WAS FALLING..THE SLEET HAD JUST ENDED.

HOWEVER..SLEET FELL IN THE COLUMBUS AREA FOR NEARLY 2 AND ONE HALF HOURS..LEAVING SECONDARY STREETS..SIDEWALKS..AND PARKING LOTS WITH A COVERING OF ICE...MAKING WALKING AND DRIVING DANGEROUS IN SOME AREAS. THE RAIN WILL BE ENDING..BUT SNOW IS IN OUR FORECAST FOR TONIGHT.

615 AM EST SAT JAN 25 1986

SNOW AND TEMPERATURES NEAR FREEZING WERE CAUSING SLIPPERY TRAVEL CONDITIONS ACROSS CENTRAL OHIO. AT 610 AM EST COLUMBUS WEATHER RADAR SHOWED PRECIPITATION FALLING OVER ALL OF CENTRAL OHIO. IT WAS MOSTLY

SNOW..BUT MIXED WITH RAIN SOUTH OF COLUMBUS.
SNOW WAS COVERING SOME SURFACES..AND SOME WET SURFACES WERE TURNING
TO ICE. SOME PARTS OF SOUTH CENTRAL OHIO MAY ALSO HAVE FREEZING RAIN.
WARMER AIR WILL GRADUALLY MOVE OUR WAY THIS MORNING AND PRECIPITATION
LATER TODAY WILL BE RAIN..BUT UNTIL THEN..BE CAUTIOUS AS YOU TRAVEL.

1035 PM EST SUN FEB 16 1986

RAIN HAS DEVELOPED OVER WEST CENTRAL OHIO AND IS MOVING EASTWARD
INTO CENTRAL OHIO.

AT 1030 AM EST THE COLUMBUS WEATHER RADAR SHOWED AN AREA OF RAIN
EXTENDING FROM JUST NORTH OF DAYTON EAST TO WESTERN FRANKLIN COUNTY
SOUTH TO WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE MOVING EAST AT 25 MPH.

TEMPERATURES ARE BELOW FREEZING ACORSS CENTRAL AT THE PRESENT TIME AND
THE RAIN WILL FREEZE ON CONTACT. DRIVING CONDITIONS WILL BECOME
HAZARDOUS AS THE FREEZING RAIN MOVES ACROSS CENTRAL OHIO DURING THE
ONE TO TWO HOURS.

FREEZING RAIN IS REPORTED FROM COLUMBUS WEST TO DAYTON AND NORTH TO
LIMA OHIO.. ALONG WITH A MIXTURE OF SLEET MOSTLY NORTH OF A COLUMBUS –
DAYTON LINE. AT 1130 AM EST THE COLUMBUS WEATHER RADAR SHOWED THE AREA
OF RAIN AND SLEET EXTENDING FROM JUST SOUTH OF FINDLAY OHIO SOUTH
THROUGH COLUMBUS TO CHILlicothe OHIO. MOVING EAST AT 25 TO 30 MPH.
TEMPERATURES ARE BELOW FREEZING ACORSS CENTRAL AT THE PRESENT TIME
AND THE RAIN WILL FREEZE ON CONTACT. DRIVING CONDITIONS WILL BECOME
HAZARDOUS AS THE FREEZING RAIN MOVES ACROSS CENTRAL OHIO THIS MORNING.
