ARKANSAS DRESSING ROOM

COACH DANNY FORD: "I apoligized to the team. They weren't prepared. That was my fault. It looked like we knew what we were doing early in the game. There was some citement. As the game wore on we turned the ball over and didn't pick up their blitzes. We didn't protect the quarterback very well. We put the ball on the ground and it was costly.

"The turnover right before the half was big. We're a fragile football team and will be for a while. We have a hard time coming back when bad things happen.

"We were outplayed. We got beat twice on long passes and they caught us in a blitz on the screen pass. We went into the game knowing we had to stop their running game and we didn't do that in the second half. We also couldn't let Flanigan scramble. He made some plays scrambling in the first half. We wanted to come after them in the second half but they didn't have to do much offensively. They hit us with the screen pass for the touchdown and really didn't need anything else.

"Offensively we were trying to control the strong safety so he wouldn't make 14 tackles against us like he did last year. We got impatient on offense. I think we would have been better on offense if we had established a running game.

"The brightest spot was Chrys Chukwuma. He played at a different speed. He made something happen when he came in the game. I didn't see much quickness from our other backs.

"I apologize to the people of Arkansas for this performance. They don't deserve a performance like that."

C.J. McLAIN: "Our football team's attitude was not right today. We underestimated SMU again. After last year I would never have thought that would happen. Once again they played harder than we did and that's what it takes to win. Their quarterback is an unbelievably athletic guy. He would get outside of us and make the big plays. Every time ou would think you had him, he would find a way to sneak out. I did what the coaches told me and kept rushing as hard as I could but it just wasn't effective."

PETE BURKS: "I think as a team and personally we didn't get the job done. I put 100 percent of the blame on my shoulders. We didn't seem to have our thinking caps on today. Mentally, we were not ready to play. We have a lot of guys on this team that are young and talented. We just need to get together and work for the next two weeks and iron out all of our problems. Our number one problem was turnovers. A team cannot expect to win when you lose the ball five times. The first fumble was all my fault. I took a good lick and lost the ball. The next time I was just trying to push too hard and lost the ball again. Even after a tough loss, I'm still confident. I'm young but definitely confident. I'm just ready to start working again for the next game."

OSCAR MALONE: "Right now we just need to prepare for Alabama. Today SMU just outplayed us. We need to overcome this game and try to come closer together as a team. After our first drive I thought things would go great the entire game. Then we just stopped executing. After their score at the end of the first half, they kept rolling with big plays in the second."

INJURY REPORT: Wide receiver ANTHONY LUCAS and linebacker ANTHONY HICKS both suffered sprained knees. Both will have MRI's tonight and more will be known Sunday.

Razorback game notes for 9/7/96 vs. SMU:

A number of Razorbacks achieved career firsts today. They include defensive backs Marcus Campbell and Zac Painter with their first career interceptions, Cory Nichols with his first career touchdown, Hubert Loudermilk with his first career reception, and Chrys Chukwuma with his first carry. Nichols also gained a career high 49 yards.

Dahrron Moss' 50-yard kickoff return was the longest by a Razorback since Madre Hill returned a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown vs. LSU in 1994

Ramon Flanigan was the first quarterback to pass for 3 touchdowns against the Razorbacks since Jay Barker of Alabama threw 3 on 9/12/92

Todd Latourette's successful PAT in the first quarter was his 25th consecutive successful PAT.

Punter Matt Wait moved ahead of Lance Alworth on the Razorback all-time list with 118.

SMU Dressing Room

COACH TOM ROSSLEY: "It is a game of momentum. Arkansas had the momentum after their first score. We were not sure what they were going to do defensively, but we were able to turn things around. I was pleases that we were able to keep our defense off the field. I'm very proud of our defense overall. They ran to the ball and they had a great week of practice. The secondary had some plays on them, but they played well. We just wanted to run our offense and defend what they were going to do in their diffferent formations. Pete Burks is going to be a great quarterback, no doubt about it. He has a lot of confidence."

LINEBACKER CRAIG SWANN: "This feels great. We have got a good ball club. Arkansas is no pushover. This proves that we have got a good ball club. All eleven of us on defense we were ready to play. We pursued the ball well and made the big plays that we needed."

QUARTERBACK RAMON FLANIGAN: "I had a shaky start, but the offense really picked me up. I think we are getting better at making the big plays downfield. The biggest thing in the second half is the fact that our quarterback had his head on straight. The offense really picked things up for me. His (Burks) job is hard because there are such big shoes to fill at quarterback for Arkansas. I expected us to play well this week. I enjoy this kind of atomosphere and hopefully the people of Dallas will see this and come out and support us."

RUNNING BACK DONTE WOMACK: "I felt that if we were able to run the ball well then it would open up our passing game. All that is important to me is that we are now 2-0. I had a lot of friends and family here and that was nice but I hold nothing against Arkansas."
