YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES | 2020 EDITION

Roll call votes by your state legislators on key small business issues are listed here. Although this Voting Record does not reflect all elements considered by a lawmaker when voting, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislators' attitude toward small business. Please thank those legislators who supported small business

- 1. NH 2 Year Budget Bill, HB 2:** relative to state fees, funds, revenues, and expenditures. (both) **A "No" vote in the Senate and House supports the NFIB position.** Passed the House 224-160 (4/11/19). Passed the Senate 14-9 (6/7/19). This budget included an immediate retroactive 12.5% tax increase on small business.
- 2. Prevailing Wage, SB 271:** relative to requiring prevailing wages on state-funded public works projects. (both) **A "No" vote in the Senate supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 14-10 on (3/14/19). **A "No" vote in the House supports the NFIB position.** Passed the House 213-140 on (5/8/19). This bill requires certain workers employed in the construction of public works in the state of New Hampshire to be paid the prevailing minimum hourly wage and benefits.
- 3. Business Taxes, SB 135 (3A) and SB 301 (3B):** These bills would increase the rate for the both the business profits and business enterprise tax. (senate vote only) **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** SB 135 Passed the Senate 14-10 on (3/14/19) and SB 301 passed the Senate 14-10 on (3/14/19). HB 623- this bill would have increased the BET by 20%. **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the House 200-141 on (2/28/19). This bill was later killed in the House after going to a second committee.
- 4. Ban the Box, SB 100:** This bill prohibits discrimination in employment based on criminal background checks. (both) **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed in the Senate 16-8 on (3/28/19). Passed the House 217-130 on (5/23/19). The bill was vetoed by the Governor.
- 5. Minimum Wage, SB 10:** This bill increases the minimum hourly rate and amends the hourly rate for tipped employees. (both) **A "No" vote on the bill supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 14-10 on (3/21/19) and passed the House 209-139 on (6/5/19). This bill was vetoed by the Governor.
- 6. Cap and Trade, HB 582:** relative to the regional greenhouse gas initiative cap and trade program for controlling carbon dioxide emissions. (both) **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the House 215-133 on (3/20/19) and passed the Senate 14-10 on (5/15/19). This bill was vetoed by the Governor.
- 7. Family Medical Leave Insurance, HB 712:** This bill establishes a system of paid family and medical leave insurance. (both) **A "No" vote in the House supports the NFIB position.** Passed the House 215-141 on (1/8/20). **A "No" vote in the Senate supports the NFIB position.** Passed in the Senate 14-10 (3/12/20). This bill was vetoed by the Governor.
- 8. Salary History, HB 211:** This bill prohibits an employer from requiring a prospective employee to disclose his or her salary history prior to an offer of employment. (both) **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the House 212-139 on (2/14/19) and passed the Senate 13-11 (5/30/19).
- 9. Credit Privacy, HB 293:** This bill prohibits employers from using credit history in employment decisions. (both) **A "Yes" vote on the motion to lay the bill on the table in the House supports the NFIB position.** Motion defeated in the House 145-212 on (3/20/19). **A "No" vote in the Senate supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 13-11 on (5/30/19). The bill was vetoed by the Governor.
