It is here with this Nicholas Cornish that the family connection becomes a bit *fuzzy*, as his true parentage has not been determined. Records indicate that he was born in Exeter and brought up in the household of Nicholas Cornish and his sister Sarah at Pullerton, in the parish of Newton St Cyres. In the 1851 census return he is referred to as *nephew* of Nicholas of Newton St Cyres, and by time the said Nicholas writes his Will in 1857 he has become his *son*. There is not the slightest doubt that the elder Nicholas ever married – this is implied in the 1841 census and stated clearly in the 1851 census. Hence, Nicholas Junior must have been an illegitimate son or somebody he was happy to declare to be his son for inheritance purposes. In 1861 Nicholas was living in Bidwell Barton, Newton St Cyres, where he was a Farmer of 155 acres. In 1863 he was declared bankrupt – his great granddaughter (Joyce Clandillon) has a desk which was owned by him and which he hid in a shed before the bailiffs came and took everything. Also saved from the sale was a silver coffee pot which is now in the possession of our family. Nicholas eventually moved to Lincolnshire and then to Northumberland where the family settled in Portland, a small hamlet near St John Lee. In 1871 and 1881 the family lived at Fences and in 19XX at Stanley Cottages, where Nicholas is now described as a Game Keeper, rather than Huntsman.

Walter William Cornish had full page Obituary in the Hexham Courant Newspaper, part of which reads – after completing his school days it was intended that he should follow his father's calling and he spent three years at the Kennels; but on other advice he became a clerk with solicitors in Hexham and after three years he entered the head office of Messrs.Lambton's Bank in Newcastle, working subsequently at Hexham, Corbridge then in 19XX he was manager of Lloyd's Bank at Hexham, there having been an amalgamation with Lambton's in 19XX. He retired on 30<sup>th</sup> Dec 19XX and few bank officials enjoyed greater esteem; his business capacity won golden opinions while his uniform courtesy and geniality was evidenced everywhere. His demise after such a short period of retirement is greatly regretted. Mr Cornish was a thorough sportsman his interest in cricket and other pastimes manifested itself throughout his life. He was a member of the

committee of management of the Tyneside Agricultural Society --- He rendered good service to St John Lee Church and was a Churchwarden for many years.

Between February1939 and May 19XX John Henry wrote three letters to his sister Alice Barlow in New Zealand. In one he reminisced about childhood – do you remember the time I cut your hair can can fashion. I certainly have never forgotten, I certainly have never forgotten that masterpiece of mine, but whether it was the splendid sartorial art in which I accomplished the feat, or the leathering I got from Dad that imprinted the memory of it on my mind, I am not prepared to say, but I rather think it was the latter. Sister Lucy appears to have escaped my barbaric clutches, but I remember very well the time I took poor little Nell into the saddle room at the kennels and then lathered her face with soap, and then proceeded to scrape it off with an iron heel plate that I had ripped off one of shoes, poor little beggar. I don't understand how she stood it, for she was very much scratched up, even at this late date I hate to dwell on the after effects of that escapade, but I do know the punishment was both severe and prolonged by both my Dear Parents. You would have thought that Dad would, after all my barbering business, put me to that trade, I feel now that I would have been a success. In his last letter he writes of his illness – my old heart simply refused to functioned properly, with the result that I have spent a big portion of my time since coming here (Vancouver) beneath the quilt. I am not going to burden you Dear Alice with a write up of my sickness, but just simply say that I was a very sick man, and really thought I was bound for the Happy Hunting Grounds, but evidently I was not wanted yet, and have made a fairly good recovery, but I am not kidding myself that I can get really better, as the Doctor says my heart is very bad, and has very little left to come and go on.
