




IN-DEPTH ANALYSIS

Ramon Magsaysay Award 2024

- In a global announcement event held, 31 August 2024, the Board of Trustees of the Ramon Magsaysay Award Foundation (RMAF) announced that this year, four individuals from Bhutan, Indonesia, Japan, and Vietnam, and one movement from Thailand will receive the Ramon Magsaysay Award.
- The renowned Japanese film director and co-founder of Studio Ghibli, Hayao Miyazaki, has been honoured with this year's prestigious Ramon Magsaysay Award, often referred to as Asia's Nobel Prize.
- The 2024 Ramon Magsaysay Awardees are:
 - Karma Phuntsho (Bhutan): Honoured for integrating Bhutan's heritage with contemporary challenges, inspiring national pride and global cultural reflection.
 - Miyazaki Hayao (Japan): Recognized for using animation to explore the human condition and inspiring imagination in children.
 - Rural Doctors Movement (Thailand): Awarded for advancing health and citizen rights for the rural poor, promoting inclusivity in economic and modern progress.
 - Nguyen Thi Ngoc Phuong (Vietnam): Celebrated for her public service and advocacy against the lasting impacts of war, providing hope and justice for its victims.
 - Farwiza Farhan (Indonesia): Given the Emergent Leadership award for her

dedication to nature, social justice, and protecting endangered natural resources.



Anubhav Awards 2024

- The 'Anubhav' portal was launched in March 2015 as a platform to highlight and recognize the tireless contributions of retiring government officials.
- The 7th Anubhav Awards Ceremony was held on August 28, 2024, at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.
- The ceremony was notable for its highest-ever representation of women awardees at 33%, reflecting their growing role in governance.
- The awards, comprising 5 Anubhav Awards and 10 Jury Certificates, recognized outstanding contributions across various categories.








24th International Mother Teresa Awards

Cambodia's Angkor Wat Named Most Photogenic Unesco World Heritage Site

- Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Manet announced that Times Travel named Angkor Wat the most photogenic UNESCO World Heritage Site in Asia.
- In the first eight months of 2024, Angkor Wat welcomed 651,857 international visitors, reflecting a 30.7% increase from the previous year.



- Most Photogenic UNESCO World Heritage Sites in Asia
 - Taj Mahal (India): Renowned for its stunning beauty and intricate marble architecture.
 - Hampi (India): An ancient city abundant with temples and historic ruins.
 - Great Wall of China (China): A monumental structure offering breathtaking scenic views.
 - Ancient City of Bagan (Myanmar): Famous for its thousands of temples and pagodas, creating a unique landscape.

- Borobudur (Indonesia): The world's largest Buddhist temple, celebrated for its architectural grandeur.
- Ha Long Bay (Vietnam): Known for its limestone islands and vibrant emerald waters, creating picturesque vistas.
- Historic Monuments of Kyoto (Japan): A collection of beautiful temples and gardens reflecting Japan's rich heritage.
- Petra (Jordan): An ancient city carved into rock, notable for its distinctive architectural style.
- Rice Terraces of the Philippine Cordilleras (Philippines): Stunning, centuries-old rice terraces that showcase ingenuity and natural beauty.
- About Angkor Wat:
 - Built in the early 12th century, Angkor Wat is the largest religious monument in the world. Originally dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu, it later transitioned to a Buddhist site.
 - The temple complex spans over 162 hectares (approximately 400 acres) and features more than 5,000 sculptures, designed to represent a miniature model of the universe in stone.
 - Since 1992, Angkor Wat has been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site


