- 100% of P-2 students involved in Early Start
- 100% of students involved wellbeing program across each term.

- Building capability of teachers through professional development and collaboration to implement the Australian Curriculum through a clear and sequenced curriculum, assessment and moderation plans.
- Embed a culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional growth and encourage reflective practices.
- Build capability of teaching staff of inclusive practices through collaborative work.
- Building data literacy to inform next steps through the use of Early Start.
- Investing in building whole school resilience connected to increase wellbeing of all staff and students. Program to be embedded and linked to identified target areas.
