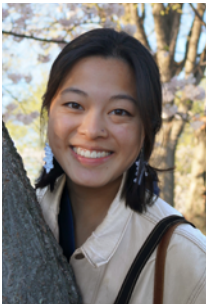
Elena Arche

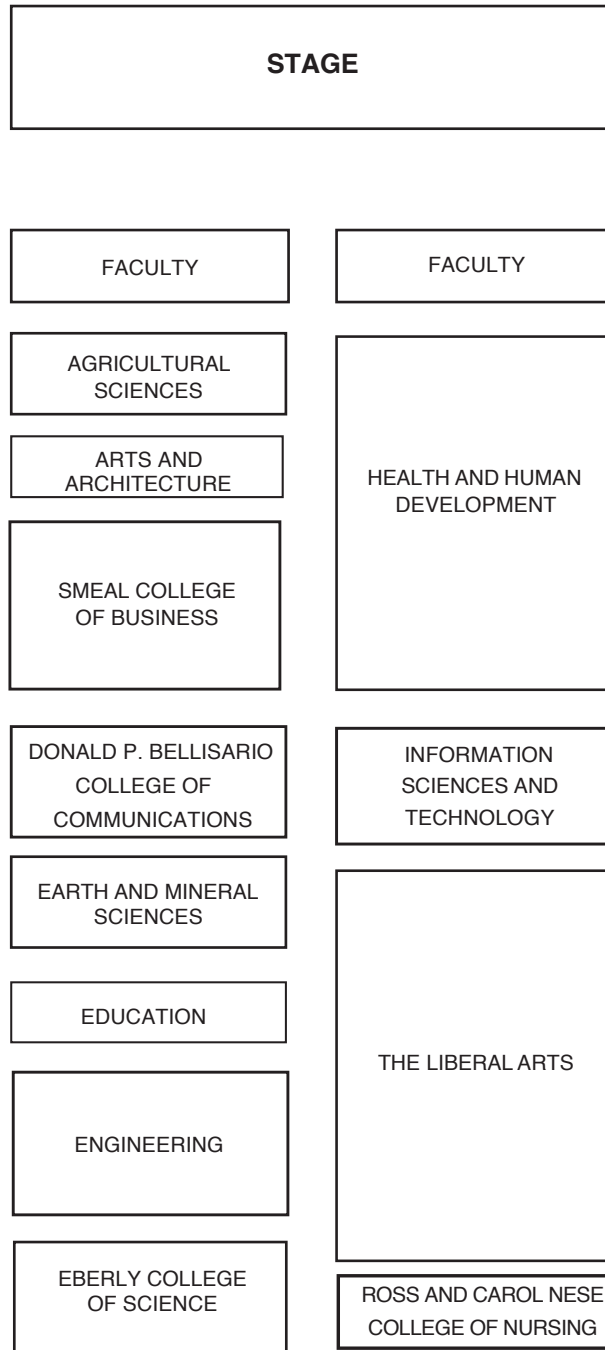
