RE: Call for Nominations for Faculty Awards

The UCI Academic Senate's Committee on Scholarly Honors and Awards (SH&A) invites you to nominate colleagues who, in your opinion, have achieved excellence and are conveying high distinction to UCI through their research, teaching or service to the University and community. The recipients of the Academic Senate's Distinguished Faculty Awards are selected by the Committee on Scholarly Honors and Awards. These Distinguished Faculty Awards provide the opportunity for the faculty to recognize the outstanding achievements of our colleagues and, by bestowing these awards upon them, make them and their contributions known to the UCI community and society at large.

The Committee urges Deans, Chairs, and other faculty members to submit nominations for these awards. The Committee strongly encourages the nomination of outstanding women and minority faculty members.

The complete list of awards and category descriptions that are open for nominations during the academic year follow:

A. Distinguished Faculty Awards

- 1) DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARD FOR RESEARCH
- 2) DISTINGUISHED MID-CAREER FACULTY AWARD FOR RESEARCH
- 3) DISTINGUISHED ASSISTANT PROFESSOR AWARD FOR RESEARCH

Recipients of the **research awards** should have made significant contributions through research and/or other creative activity that has had a major impact on the field, either through a career-long record of contributions, or as a result of a major contribution.

The Distinguished Mid-Career Faculty Award for Research will be awarded to Senate members who have achieved the rank of Associate Professor through Professor V at the time of the nomination.

- 4) DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARD FOR TEACHING
- 5) DISTINGUISHED ASSISTANT PROFESSOR AWARD FOR TEACHING



Recipients of the **teaching awards** should have made significant contributions to the educational mission of the campus through distinguished teaching at the undergraduate, graduate, and/or professional levels.

- 6) DANIEL G. ALDRICH, JR. DISTINGUISHED UNIVERSITY SERVICE AWARD
- 7) DISTINGUISHED MID-CAREER FACULTY AWARD FOR SERVICE

Recipients of the **service awards** should have made outstanding contributions of service to the University of California. The Daniel G. Aldrich, Jr. Distinguished University Service Award will be awarded to a respected scholar at any rank. Service is defined as activities that enhance the mission of the University and lead to the improvement of the academic and/or personal lives of significant segments of the University community.

The Distinguished Mid-Career Faculty Award for Service will be awarded to Senate members who have achieved the rank of Associate Professor through Professor V at the time of the nomination.

- 8) DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARD FOR MENTORSHIP

Recipients of the **mentorship award** should have made outstanding contributions through mentoring of students or other faculty that takes place outside of a traditional teaching or research relationship and outside their formal advising duties. This award will recognize mentoring activities that are not accompanied by additional financial compensation. Special consideration will be given to mentoring junior faculty; mentoring with the intent to address gender equity and ethnic diversity; and altruistic mentoring.

The Committee on Scholarly Honors and Awards will normally not give an award in any category where there are an insufficient number of nominees.

In addition to completing the application questions, all nominations must include the following:

- 1) A current and complete curriculum vitae (required).
- 2) One nomination letter (required, maximum length – 2 pages)
- 3) Up to two supporting letters may be included (maximum length – 2 pages) specifically solicited for this nomination.

For **teaching award nominations**, please include one set of formal teaching evaluation questionnaires, but not letters of support from individual students.

For **mentoring award nominations**, if you are nominating your mentor, please state how his/her mentoring has changed or encouraged your academic or career plans. (max 250 words)

The Committee on Scholarly Honors and Awards urges every faculty member to participate in the celebration of excellence at UCI by identifying outstanding Senate colleagues for these Senate awards. If your nomination of a candidate is unsuccessful this year, we urge you to consider re-submission in future years.

If you wish to re-nominate a Senate member whose name was submitted last year, please send a brief memo to that effect, including any updated materials, to the Senate analyst of the Committee on Scholarly Honors and Awards, Christine Aguilar (cmaguil1@uci.edu).

The recipients of all eight Senate awards will be honored during the following academic year at an annual Senate event and they will be known as the Academic Senate's Distinguished Faculty Award recipients for 2018-19. The recipient of the Distinguished Faculty Award for Research will be invited to present a short public talk at the annual event, followed by a reception hosted by the Chancellor and Executive Vice Chancellor/Provost. In addition, the winners of all eight Senate awards each receives a monetary award of \$3000 that will be transferred to a departmental account.

A list of previous Senate faculty award recipients is attached for your information. Previous award recipients are not precluded from receiving future awards in other categories. Members of the Committee on Scholarly Honors and Awards are precluded from receiving Senate awards during their terms of service.
