00:05	The Albion Park Rail bypass - the 'missing link' for a high standard motorway between Sydney and Bomaderry.
00:15	The bypass would deliver significant benefits to local communities and motorists by reducing congestion at a notorious Illawarra bottleneck.
00:26	The NSW Government has committed \$630 million of funding to construct the bypass, major work is expected to commence in early 2019, the bypass will be open to traffic in 2022.

00:43	During Construction the Albion Park Rail bypass is expected to generate around 550 jobs.
00:48	Safeguarding the future, the motorway would be built for two lanes in each direction, with capacity for a third.

01:38	Yallah Road will now pass under the motorway, this will mean reduced excavation and construction impacts.

01:54	The proposed Albion Park Rail bypass, would bypass 16 intersections including six sets of traffic lights, enable more efficient travel between Heathcote and Bomaderry, and return local streets to local communities.
02:36	Access during a flood would be improved with the motorway being an alternative route to the Princes Highway.
03:03	In consultation with the community, the sporting complex is being reconfigured and directly impacted sporting facilities are being replaced with similar facilities.
03:12	After the motorway passes over Tongarra Road, it travels through the Croome Regional Sporting Complex and under Croome Road.
03:20	The sporting complex reconfiguration is currently under construction by Cleary Brothers.
03:26	By bypassing 16 intersections the Albion Park Rail bypass is expected to cut northbound travel times in the morning by almost 33 percent, or three minutes.
03:38	This would also mean major time and fuel savings for freight and transport operators with continuous free flowing travel between Yallah and Oak Flats.
03:49	In the south, the motorway would travel under the existing Oak Flats Interchange to connect to the existing Princes Highway.
