This self-assessment checklist has been developed specifically for non-food producing businesses that require HACCP Food Safety Certification.

- Examples of these businesses include;
- transportation & warehousing companies,
 - package and labelling manufactures,
 - pest controllers and
 - site cleaners.



- Has the business specified requirements in the form of Management Plans, Standard Operating Procedures or other systems?
- Has a Hazard Analysis / Risk Assessment been undertaken for Food related Risks?
- Is there evidence that a person in control has knowledge and skills in Food Safety and Food Hygiene?
- Are there processes to manage risks? Eg. cleaning, maintenance, pest control programs, as appropriate.
- Has the organisation processes to inspect incoming goods?
- Is there a method for approving suppliers?
- Are there processes for identification and traceability of products and services?
- Is there a recall process appropriate to the organisations activities?
- Is there a process defining how non-conformity or significant issues are addressed?
