

### **GALACTIC BLOOM**


Since the Public Art Committee's inception in 2012, the City has acquired sculptures, murals, wrapped traffic boxes, and even created an underwater sculpture garden. Pompano Beach Arts worked with Tyler FuQua Creations (TFC) to create a light pole sculpture that is located in Old Town at 11 NE 1st St. entitled Galactic Bloom. This sculpture represents, as the artist describes it, a space plant. With its whimsical nature, the story of the space plants states that they first appeared in Portland Oregon in 2000. In 2024, a seed ended up traversing the US and ended up in Pompano Beach! The plant seems to have evolved slightly along the way, resulting in this Galactic Bloom! This space plant stands about 12 feet tall and has 4 blossoms at various heights and is made out of stainless steel.

This is not the first time Tyler FuQua Creations has worked with Pompano Beach. Tyler and his team created Mechan H2O, a sculpture representing a robot scuba diver, which was originally placed on-land for a year before being sunk and attached to the Lady Luck in Shipwreck Park.

The City's Public Art Committee meets every third Thursday at 5 pm at the Pompano Beach Cultural Center. Meetings are open to the public and all are welcome to join!

Bailey Contemporary Arts Artists in Residence (AiR) Program

The City of Pompano Beach Cultural Affairs Department is delighted to introduce the 2024/2025 class of our Artists in Residence (AiR) program at the historic Bailey Contemporary Arts Center (BaCA).

The AiR Program provides artists with studio space to create new work, collaborate with fellow resident artists, and engage with the community. This dynamic and diverse group of artists will be in residence though June, and we will present each as an "Artist of the Month," offering them the opportunity to showcase their work and create unique programs to attract art lovers to BaCA.



Nino Liguori has always enjoyed telling stories through his paintings, which are visual parables and allegories. His work alludes to art history, design, innovation, and humanity itself, intertwining fable and fact, imagination and realism. An art educator, he has worked with diverse socio-economic and racial

groups in Broward County and was twice a finalist for Visual Arts Educator of the Year.

Liguori advanced his painting studies by obtaining a master's degree in Europe and Asia. He studied at The Academie de Beaux Arts in Paris, collaborated with art collectives in Rome, and learned brush and breathing techniques in East Asia. His artwork has been featured in New York Magazine and Hi-Fructose Magazine. Honoring both his Italian heritage and the storytelling nature of his work, he signs his paintings "ALIGUORI."









### CONSTANCE IVANA



With a lifelong passion for art and a mission to expand artistic access, Constance Ivana uses her creative voice to tackle issues of social justice and Black history, primarily through vibrant works in spray paint and acrylics. Currently an artist-in-residence at History Fort Lauderdale, her pieces are often imbued with messages of hope and encouragement.

A retired Broward County educator with 21 years of teaching experience. she transitioned to HR recruiting. Ivana is a regular volunteer with the City of Fort Lauderdale and has fostered collaborations with a wide range of organizations, including the Broward Center for the Performing Arts, YMCA, Boys and Girls Club, Art Prevails, Art 13, Art n Soul, Heal the Planet, numerous schools, independent artists, and various nonprofits. Beyond selling her artwork, Ivana actively engages the community by hosting painting parties and workshops, and creating impactful murals.



Alyssa Book is a Cuban American fiber artist who uses rug tufting techniques to create one-of-a-kind, tactile works of art. Based in South Florida, Book's vibrant style uses bold lines and bright colors to evoke a sense of childlike wonder.

After a challenging experience with postpartum depression, Book turned to her craft as a source of solace and healing. Inspired by the Woodstock era and the inherent restorative power of color, she creates yarn art that sparks joy and inner peace. Her works have been exhibited at galleries throughout South Florida's Tri-County area.


