- Suspect FIC episode

### **History:**

- Acute-onset stranguria, this happened about 2 weeks ago as well. Jonas is licking at his prepuce excessively. No other PPHx.

### **Vaccination Status:**

- UTD

### **Physical Exam:**

**Temperature (°F):** 100.5

**Pulse (BPM):** 200

**Respiration (RPM):** 36

**Weight (kg):** 8.1

**EENT:** Clear OU/AU, neg cervical examination, no nasal discharge

**Oral:** mm pink and moist, CRT <2

**PLN:** NSF

**H/L:** No heart murmur auscultated, strong/synchronous pulses noted, lungs clear bilaterally/eupneic

**ABD:** soft non-painful, no masses palpated

**MS/I:** Ambulatory x4, good hair coat BCS: 9/9 MCS: 3/3

**UG:** fluctuant expressible bladder, no preputial discharge, preputial region erythematous, nothing on the penis tip noted

**Rectal:** no masses palpated, normal stool, anal sacs wnl

**N:** alert & appropriate
