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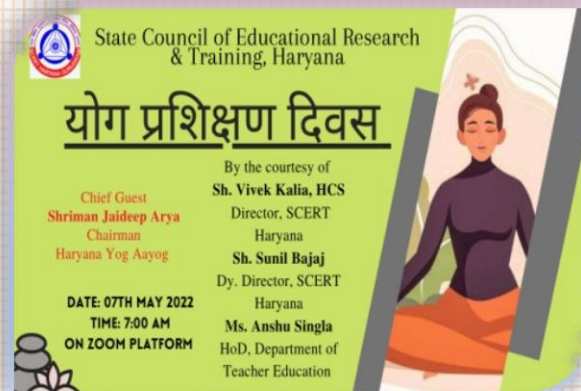
राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के अंतर्गत विद्यालयी स्तर पर स्कूली शिक्षा का विभाजन 3-8, 8-11, 11-14 तथा 14-18 वर्ष की उम्र के बच्चों के अनुसार किया गया है, जिसमें प्रारंभिक अवस्था प्री-प्राइमरी स्कूल के 3 साल, कक्षा 1-2 सहित फाउंडेशन स्टेज होगी। विद्या प्रवेश, राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी 2020) की सिफारिशों के अनुसार पहली कक्षा के लिए तीन महीने का खेल आधारित स्कूल तैयारी मॉड्यूल है, जो एन०सी०ई०आर०टी०, नई दिल्ली द्वारा तैयार किया गया है। यह दस्तावेज उन सभी बच्चों की विकासात्मक और सीखने की जरूरतों को संबोधित करने का इरादा रखता है जो कक्षा-1 में प्रवेश करते हैं, साथ ही यह मॉड्यूल विद्यालयी शिक्षा में बच्चों के प्रवेश को सहज, सुगम और आनंदमय बनाने में भी शिक्षकों की मदद करेगा। एस०सी०ई०आर०टी० हरियाणा, गुरुग्राम को विद्या प्रवेश मॉड्यूल का हिंदी अनुवाद करने का



दायित्व सौंपा गया। अनुवाद हेतु परिषद् के विषय-विशेषज्ञों के साथ-साथ कुछ जिला प्रशिक्षण संस्थानों के विषय-विशेषज्ञों का चयन किया गया। मॉड्यूल की समीक्षा व संशोधन उपरांत गुरुग्राम जिले के 10 विद्यालयों के प्राथमिक शिक्षकों की एक दिवसीय कार्यशाला आयोजित की गई जिसमें सभी अध्यापकों ने उक्त मॉड्यूल का अध्ययन किया। अध्ययन के बाद अध्यापकों के सुझावों का समावेश करते हुए विद्या प्रवेश मॉड्यूल को अंतिम रूप प्रदान करने उपरांत निदेशक, मौलिक शिक्षा, पंचकूला तथा शिक्षा व साक्षरता विभाग, शिक्षा मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार को प्रेषित किया गया।

Yog Training Day

To popularize Yog in daily life of students, Education Department has decided to celebrate 1st Saturday of every month as Yog Training Day. In this context 7th May 2022 was observed as Yog Training Day. SCERT Haryana along with Ayush Department and Haryana Yog Aayog organized live session for teachers & students. All schools were invited out of which 360 schools joined this online yog session. The participants were welcomed and motivated to practice yog in their daily life.



Induction Training Program for Newly Appointed BRPs and ABRCs

Induction training plays vital role in preparing the new entrants in any organization for preparing them in discharging their responsibilities. 24 Newly appointed BRPs and ABRCs from different districts were imparted a 5-day training from 23rd May to 27th May 2022. Training was imparted by the experts of SCERT and from various institutions of higher education. Following important topics were covered in this training:

- School Based Assessment
- 21st Century Skills, Foundational Literacy and Numeracy under NIPUN Bharat
- Multidisciplinary aspects of Environment
- Science
- Mentoring and Monitoring
- Importance of Action Research



The participants were given opportunity to understand DIKSHA Portal, AVASAR App and SAMIKSHA App through hands-on-practice. Participants were encouraged to participate in different activities and their enthusiasm was praiseworthy. Director SCERT, addressed the participants and also had the feedback of the training. He motivated the participants to perform their duties in a better way in the field to improve the quality and operational efficiency of education department.

Induction Training on School Leadership to Newly Promoted Principals

To enhance leadership capacities and to imbibe the basic knowledge of administration and teaching learning process a two-week Induction Training was imparted to 58 newly promoted principals of Jhajjar & Palwal districts from 19th May to 30th May 2022. The training was focussed on:

- Improving Teaching Learning Process
- Team-building
- Innovation in Education
- Administrative Aspects of School Leadership



The execution of training contained lectures, group discussions, personality development programmes and team building activities. The participants were motivated to execute the knowledge and experience gathered from the training in the work field. Director and Joint Directors motivated the participants and team SLA for the successful conduct of the induction training.

NISHTHA 3.0 (FLN)

Batch 2 for Nishtha 3.0 courses started in the beginning of May and the date for completing the courses was 31st May 2022. The weekly reports of this batch were shared with NCERT and District coordinators on regular basis.

Teacher handbook of Yog being developed for classes 1st to 5th

Workshops are being conducted in SCERT to develop the content for the teacher Handbook of Yog Education. Yog education will become an integral part of the school curriculum from the current academic session.

PROJECT UDAAN: Recent Developments

State-wide Orientation for Project UDAAN

An online orientation was conducted for all the district functionaries, DEOs / DEEOs/ DPCs/ APCs and DIET Principals on the Project UDAAN. Insights about the implementation of the project were discussed. Two hours of remedial teaching is to be assimilated in the school time table. The UDAAN modules are pre-requisite competency based. These modules will address the learning gaps created in the past two years due to Covid-19 and also support the subsequent classes.



Pedagogical Training to Teachers for Project UDAAN

An online orientation was conducted for all the JBTs teaching classes 4th and 5th and the TGTs of subjects namely English, Hindi, Math and Science. Pedagogical aspects of the modules were explained by the subject coordinators of SCERT. Teachers were explained how pre-requisite competencies can support at-grade level learning.

Content Development of UDAAN Phase 2

Project UDAAN Phase 1, is being accepted well by the students and teachers alike. On similar lines the task of the second phase has been initiated and workshops for all the subjects have been organized for the development of the content.

Orientation of State Resource Group for Content Creation and Content Review (Part 1)

E-learning is becoming very powerful and effective tool of learning nowadays. To promote this mode of learning, Educational Technology wing is working on e-content creation and its review for quality check. A state resource group has been formed and orientation of this State resource group for content creation and content review (Part 1) has been done on 31st May 2022.



Live Interaction on Digital Initiative in Education in Haryana

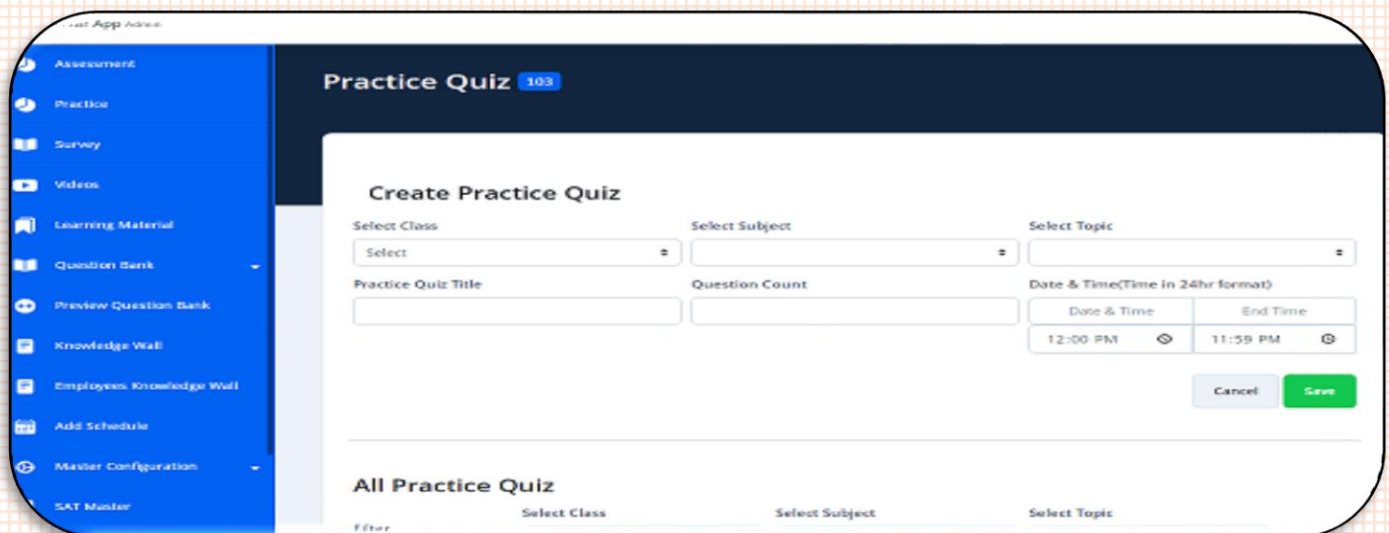


Practice Question on AVSAR App for SAT Preparation:



To provide self-assessment platform to students through practice quiz before SAT Cycles, an exercise of creating, reviewing and uploading a series of practice questions (minimum of 20 questions per chapter) on AVSAR App has been started in the month of May 2022 by Testing & Assessment wing of the council. The details of subject wise uploaded practice questions for SAT Cycle -1 by the end of May are as under:

Subject	Class	Number of questions
Math	4 th to 8 th	200 questions
Science	4 th to 8 th	200 questions
English	6 th to 8 th	180 questions



By the end of June, practice questions will be made available for all main subjects such as Hindi, English, Mathematics, Science, EVS and social Science for class 4th to 8th for SAT Cycle -1. This practice will be continued throughout the year for all SAT Cycles
