**6th Amendment**

**7th Amendment**

**8th Amendment**

Your dad breaks a law in Nebraska and goes to jail, but is told that the trial will be in New Jersey.

**9th Amendment**

Your grandpa is told he can't own a gun for hunting.

**10th Amendment**

The government commandeers your house to build a new road.
