

REPLACING RESOLUTIONS 96-09, 98-05 & 05-06 & AMENDING PORTIONS OF
03-11

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. 94 of the City of Hayward, duly adopted on April 5, 1954, provided that the City Council may make regulations by resolution or by motion, for the management and care of Greenwood Cemetery,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the following regulations shall apply to Greenwood Cemetery and any subsequent additions to Greenwood Cemetery:

1. Burials must be in concrete burial vaults or equivalent.
2. No person shall plant any trees or shrubs on any lot or grave of such addition to Greenwood Cemetery.
3. No person shall erect any fence, concrete curbing, flower urn, or other structure which, in the opinion of the Cemetery Committee or City Council, may hinder the care of the Greenwood Cemetery.
4. No monument, headstone, marker, foundation, memorial or any object shall be erected or placed prior to obtaining a permit from the Public Works Department. The fee for the permit shall be \$35.00. The Public Works Department shall mark each grave before placement of any monument, headstone, marker, foundation, memorial or object.
5. All above ground monuments, headstone, markers, foundations or memorials shall be centered and placed at the head (west) of each lot. Those placed on single lots shall be a maximum of 30 inches and the foundation (base) shall be a maximum of 40 inches. All foot markers shall be centered and placed at the foot (east) of each lot. Foot markers shall be flush with the ground.
6. All grave stones or markers shall be set upon concrete foundations and shall be set within the lot line one (1) foot from the outside edge of such lot or grave.
7. The Cemetery Sexton or designee shall have the right to remove any flower box, container or stand, in all sections of Greenwood Cemetery, which may hinder efficient grass mowing..
8. Only one moveable pot or basket of flowers may be placed on each lot. This is not subject to the permit in 4. above.
9. No objects are to be placed on or in the ground other than those allowed in Item 4 & Item 8.
10. All grave sites will be cleared of all decoration by October 1 of each year as the final clean-up and again in the spring before Memorial Day.
11. Those grave sites in nonconformance of the above will have 30 days after notification to bring such sites into compliance. After this date the Cemetery Sexton, or designee may remove any illegal plantings, memorials or objects.
