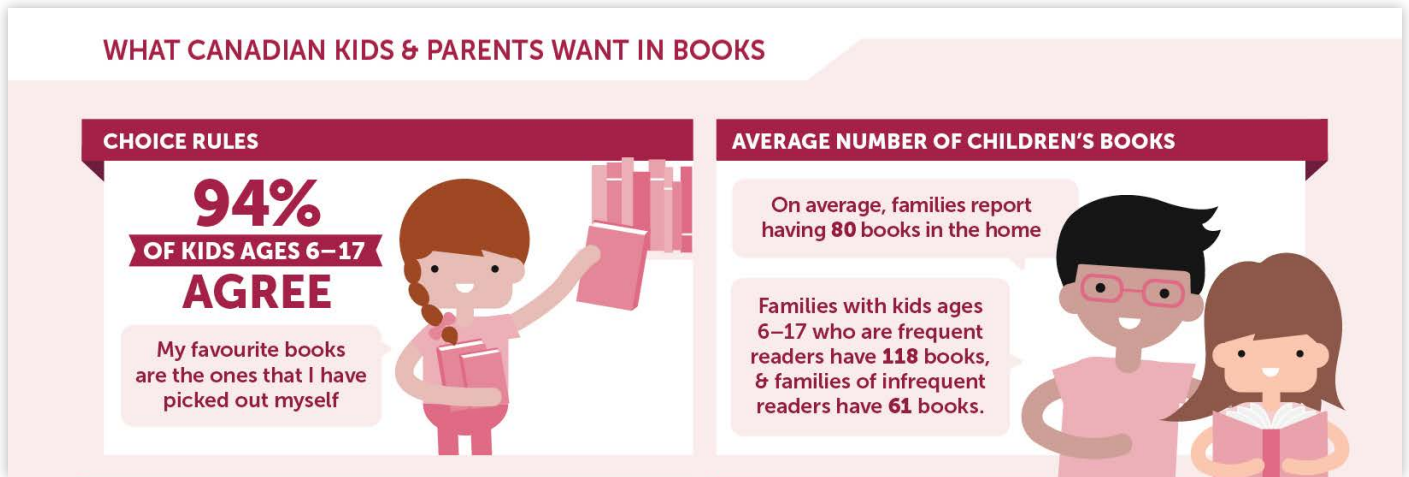

Free shipping to the classroom is back!

Shipping books to the classroom helps teachers create an in-class event to get students excited about reading.

1 Create an account on our website. Make sure you have selected 'Yes' when asked if you are running Book Clubs. Teachers who are running Book Clubs must accept consolidated classroom orders. Existing Book Clubs teachers can sign in at: [scholastic.ca/bookclubs](https://www.scholastic.ca/bookclubs)

2 Share the flyers and your Class Code with families. Set a due date for the classroom order. You will receive an email every time a family places an order.

3 When parents shop from Book Clubs they can:

- Shop from thousands of items available online.
- Ship books to the classroom, or choose to ship right to their home for a fee.
- Submit their order and payment online.

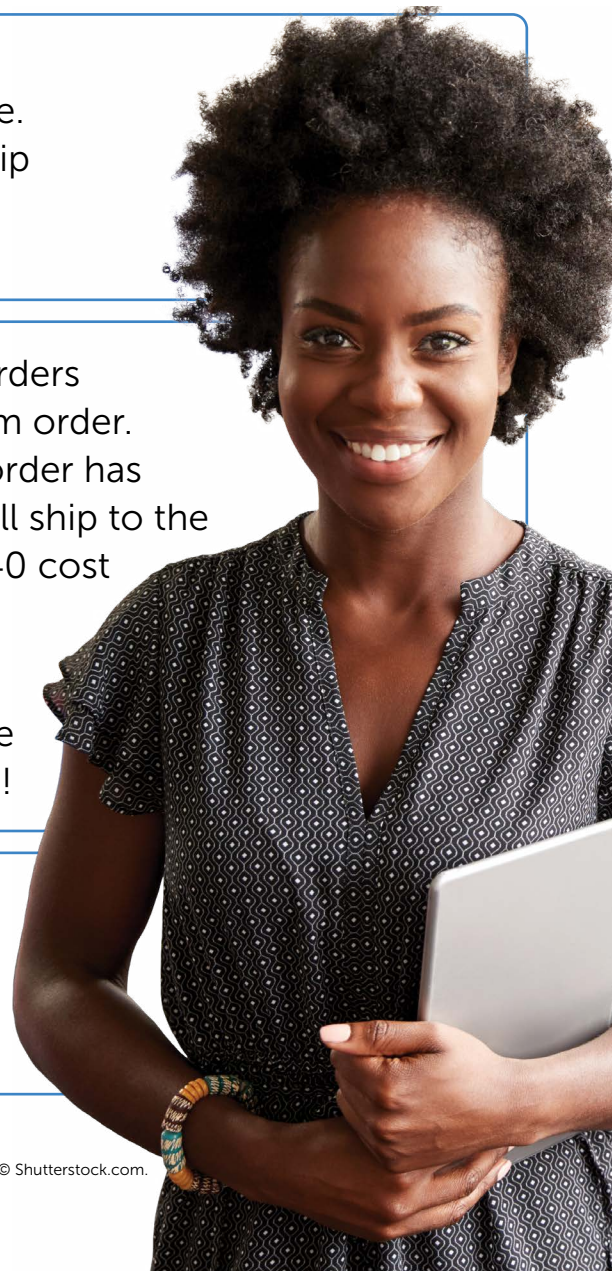
4 When the set due date arrives, add your own orders to the cart, and submit the combined classroom order. Parents receive an email when the classroom order has been submitted. Classroom orders over \$40 will ship to the school for FREE. Classroom orders less than \$40 cost only \$7.50 to ship.

5 The classroom order will ship right to the school. You will receive a packing slip with students' names and their items to make distribution easy.

Here are some helpful tips to help you reach a \$40 consolidated classroom order so you can benefit from free shipping!

- Send home a parent letter**
Regular communication keeps families involved. Send home a parent letter that includes your class literacy goals and your classroom wishlist!
- Talk up books in the classroom**
When you hand out the flyer, take time to talk-up your favourite titles on the monthly flyer and get your students excited about reading!
- Add your own items to the cart**
If your classroom order is under \$40, go shopping on [scholastic.ca/bookclubs](https://www.scholastic.ca/bookclubs) and add items you need most to your cart!
- Talk to other teachers and run the Book Clubs program together!**
Talk to other teachers for your grade and offer to run the program for the entire grade! Use one Class Code and split the rewards.

Promoting Book Clubs!

Family involvement is key to the success of your Book Club.

- 1 Send the Book Club flyer home with students. You may want to include a letter to parents to encourage families to participate. You can find some on the Book Clubs website!
- 2 Advertise in your school newsletter! Let families know how important a home filled with books is for creating lifelong readers. Be clear how ordering from Book Clubs benefits their child and the classroom.
- 3 Stay top-of-mind with social media posts. You can share when the flyers are out and when orders are due. You can also follow us on Instagram or Facebook and share our posts: @scholasticbookclubscanada
- 4 Create a Classroom Wishlist and make recommendations for your students! You can easily add titles to these lists when you log into your Book Clubs account on our website.

Increasing classroom participation to encourage a **love of reading**

Here are some ways teachers have increased classroom participation in Book Clubs:

- ◆ Display the classroom poster found on our website to showcase favourite characters, new books, and the date that orders are due.
- ◆ Kids LOVE looking at the flyers when they arrive. At the end of the day, spend 10 minutes looking over them with the class and have them point out books that interest them.
- ◆ Allow students who are familiar with a particular book or author to share their enthusiasm.
- ◆ Point out one or two books to each student that you know they would love to read.

Classroom Wishlist

The Classroom Wishlist is an easy way to keep parents updated on the learning materials your classroom needs. Create a list of the resources you need to create a print-rich environment in the classroom that benefits every student. By building a Classroom Wishlist, families can help you build healthy reading habits in every student.

Parents can gift a book to your class by selecting "Gift to Class" under the books on your wishlist. Once purchased, the wishlist will be automatically updated to show the remaining titles. Gifts will be shipped with student orders to your classroom. Remember to keep the list refreshed and ready with new titles!

Teacher Recommendations

Parents appreciate knowing which books their child's teacher recommends. In addition to the Classroom Wishlist, you can suggest titles for parents to purchase for their child. You can also make notes on why you have recommended the books.

It's easy to get started:

- 1** Visit [scholastic.ca/bookclubs](https://www.scholastic.ca/bookclubs) and log in using 'My Account' at the top of the page.
- 2** Shop the digital flyers and add titles to your lists. You can add an item by clicking the heart icon. You can also find this button on the search results and Product Detail pages.
- 3** Select the list you want to add the item to in the drop-down (hint: you can add an item to as many lists as you want!)

Earning Rewards

Parents place their orders online and YOU get rewards! You're also rewarded on your own orders.

Here's how it works:

- 1 You'll be mailed paper flyers five times during the school year. Send these home with your students so they can select something they're excited to read! Families can also shop from the digital flyers posted on the site.
- 2 Share your Class Code with families. Class Code links all your classroom orders back to you for Bonus Bank Rewards, our rewards currency. Every order where your Class Code is applied, including your own, earns you rewards.
