- 1** Click on 'My Account' at the top of the page, select 'Sign In' or 'Create an Account', and follow the directions.
- 2** Children will receive flyers at school. Teachers will set a due date for class orders, and provide their Class Code. Review the flyer as a family, then place your order and pay online before the due date.
- 3** Your child's teacher will provide their Class Code, or use the 'Find a Class Code' link in your account settings. Enter or search for a Class Code when you log into your account. You can also enter the Class Code in the 'Class Codes' section during the checkout process.
- 4** Select the classroom you want to ship to by adding a teacher's Class Code to your order at checkout. Orders placed using Class Code ship for FREE to the classroom. Teachers will receive an email every time a parent order is placed. Shipping to home is available for a fee.
- 5** Classroom orders placed using a teacher's Class Code earn 20% of the order value* in rewards that can be used to purchase valuable educational resources that benefit every child in the class.

Classroom Wishlist

The Classroom Wishlists are an easy way to keep updated on the types of learning materials your child's teacher needs. The teacher creates a list of the materials they need to create a print-rich environment in their classroom that benefits every student. By supporting your teacher's Classroom Wishlist, you help build healthy reading habits in your child.

To gift a book to your teacher, simply select "Gift to Class" under the book on the wishlist. Gifts will show separately in your cart, but will ship to your classroom together with books you have purchased for your home.

Pro tip: Titles on Classroom Wishlists can also be great picks for your child's home library!

Teacher Recommendations

Parents appreciate knowing which books their child's teacher recommends. In addition to the Classroom Wishlist, your child's teacher can suggest just-right books for you to purchase for your child. They can also make notes explaining why they have recommended the titles.

It's easy to get started:

- 1** Visit [scholastic.ca/bookclubs](https://www.scholastic.ca/bookclubs) and click on 'My Account' at the top of the page to log in. If you don't have an account, select 'Create an Account' and follow the directions.
- 2** Make sure you are connected to a teacher via their Class Code! If you don't know your child's teacher's Class Code, you can search for it using the 'Find a Class Code' option.
- 3** Once a Class Code is linked, you'll be able to see the teacher's Classroom Wishlist and Teacher Recommendations on the homepage!

A**ALLOCATE TIME**

Make reading a part of your everyday routine.

D**DIVERSIFY**

Introduce different genres (e.g., mysteries, biographies, sci-fi, etc.).

E**ENGAGE**

Make it fun (e.g., help your child organize a local book club with peers).

R**READ TOGETHER**

Participate by taking turns reading passages aloud.

S**SUPPORT**

Provide your child access to books (e.g., build up your child's home library).
