

INTERCOLLEGIATE RIFLE TEAM TROPHY



The Intercollegiate Rifle Team Trophy is an upright, sterling silver vase with two handles and the SAR Crest centered on the vase front. It sits on a metal block base with engraved plates. It was presented to NRA in 1928 by the General Society Sons of the Revolution for annual rifle competition among the colleges and universities of the United States.

Match Conditions:

- 1928 Team of five firing members, one alternate, Team Captain, and Coach. Ten shots per firing member, 50 feet indoor.
- 1960 Team firing members reduced from five to four.
- 1975 Target change from conventional A-17 to NRA A-36 target.
- 1979 Trophy winner changed from 1200 point aggregate under the NRA 3-Position Rules, to 4800 point aggregate under the NRA International Rules.
- 1980 Rededicated for competition in the NCAA Rifle Championships and awarded to the NCAA Rifle Team Champions (aggregate team scores of smallbore rifle and air rifle team).
- 1982 Rededicated for competition in the NRA Intercollegiate Sectionals and awarded to the smallbore rifle team with the highest score. Course of fire: 3-Position, 4 member team, 4800 shot aggregate.
- 2005 Course of fire changed to 60 shots per team member.
