Curriculum

We offer a full education for children between the ages of 3 and 18 years old.

From the age of 5, all our students follow the Cambridge Pathway, a British curriculum developed by Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE, part of the University of Cambridge) that offer them the chance to acquire the knowledge and skills they need to achieve at school, university and beyond.

Leading universities around the world, including in the US and especially the UK, recognize the Cambridge qualifications.





Curriculum



The Cambridge programmes combine an emphasis on mastering subjects in depth, at the same time as developing higher order thinking skills for study and work in the future.

Deep subject knowledge helps develop the ability to solve problems, to apply understanding to new situations, and to enable learners to progress to the next stage.

As well as encouraging pupils to develop higher order thinking skills within subject disciplines – problem-solving, critical thinking, independent research, collaboration, presenting arguments – we believe students need to work effectively across disciplines.

Curriculum

Alongside the Cambridge curriculum, a majority of our pupils follow the National State curriculum and take the Unified State Exams that allows them easy access to State universities if a student chooses not to study abroad.



Multilingual Education



- All subjects of the British curriculum are taught in English by experienced teachers from such countries as: the UK, USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and South Africa. As a result, all our pupils have a fluent working knowledge and experience of English. Meanwhile, all the subjects of the State Curriculum are taught in national language by experienced teachers.
- There are numerous documented benefits enjoyed by multilingual children beyond knowing two or more languages fluently. Such benefits include improvements across all subjects, increased attention span, demonstrating more developed social and emotional skills, and protection against cognitive decline and dementia in old age.
