## L & E Bottling Company Scholarship Fund

#### Overview

The L & E Bottling Company Scholarship Fund was established by the L & E Bottling Company, Inc. to assist graduating high school seniors in Thurston County in obtaining a higher education. This scholarship may be renewable for up to an additional three years of undergraduate education. \$1,000 award.

### **Eligibility & Selection Criteria**

Selection of award recipient is based on a combination of merit and financial need.

- 1. Merit is determined using the following factors:
  - <u>Demonstrated academic ability:</u> A student need not be at the top of his/her class, but must have demonstrated a capacity to succeed in school
  - <u>Career Goals:</u> An indication of how the scholarship will contribute to future career goals.
  - <u>Extracurricular Activities/Community Service</u>: Participation in school and volunteer activities which indicate a commitment to the community.
  - Applicant Appraisal: Two letters of recommendation
  - Other: Special circumstances such as family, financial, or personal problems that may make an applicant more worthy of consideration.
- 2. Preference will be given to students demonstrating significant financial need, which is assessed using the completed Student Aid Report (SAR) that takes into consideration current family income, accumulated assets, family size, and number of family members in school.

### A complete application packet requires:

#### ✓ Profile Form

Make certain all information provided is legible, especially the email address as that will be our main method of communicating information to you.

#### ✓ Personal Statement

Write a short statement indicating your reasons for wanting to attend a post-secondary institution, your course of study, and your career goals. Include other information that will show the Committee you are a worthy scholarship recipient (e.g. outstanding attributes, talents, service to school or community, commitment to pursuing educational goals, motivation and family circumstances).

#### √ Two Letters of Recommendation

- A successful letter of recommendation will remark on the student's overall character, achievement and promise
- One of the letters must be from a teacher/advisor
- The letters must have been written within the last year and must contain your full name
- Please **do not** send more than two letters of recommendation.

#### ✓ Grade Transcript

Include a copy of your most recent grade transcript. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.

#### ✓ Copy of Student Aid Report (SAR)

A completed SAR is used to determine your financial need. This document is returned to you when you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available from many high school counselors or college financial aid offices. **Be certain that your report includes an EFC number.**
