Fire Chief's Report for December 2023

FIRE & EMS Report

Response calls: 38 Fire runs, and 139 EMS calls were made in December for a total of 177 calls for service. For the year, we made 660 fire calls and 1627 EMS calls for a total of 2287 runs.

CPR: There was one CPR class in December. CPR classes are available if citizens call and ask.

Training: For the year members completed 2760 hours of training. This may be the greatest number of training hours for a year in the history of FDBD.

FIRE INSPECTIONS

Crews completed 4 inspections in December.

KNOX BOX PROGRAM

There were no new Knox Boxes installed in December.

BURN PERMITS

There were no burn permits issued in December. Any open burning within the city limits must have a burn permit issued from the fire department.

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

December was a busy month for our crews. We finished winterizing the hydrants and confirming any wet or malfunctioning ones with the water district. We participated in Light Up Dayton by delivering Santa on the fire truck. And we had another successful FDBD Christmas program, where we assisted 10 families and 26 kids in having a better Christmas. Santa was again on our fire truck as we went around the cities on December 23rd to make our deliveries. There aren't enough thanks to give to everyone that contributed or donated in some way to make this another great year.

I attended a Medical Preparedness and Response for Bombing Incidents class. This completed the requirements to obtain my Community Disaster Preparedness for Healthcare certification from Texas A&M. We had one member complete paramedic

school and will be testing shortly. Another member will be starting paramedic school in January. Completing this school is no easy task, taking up much of your personal time for studies, in addition to clinicals and ride time. Both members are to be commended for choosing to undertake this.

This year ended up on a positive note, as we have been fully staffed since July. There are departments surrounding us with higher pay that cannot hire people. This is a direct result of the continued openness and collaboration between the cities and the fire department. Your willingness to listen, communicate and continue to move forward with growth allows me to do my job and hire quality, dedicated members, who want to be here, and protect these cities. I see this every day, but the two letters of thanks attached to this report, and the recent Channel 5 report on an amazing cardiac arrest resuscitation are just examples of what our members do every day.

I look forward to what 2024 will bring to the cities and FDBD, and I am honored to continue to represent this department.
