- **As of 8/30/24 there are 27 outstanding minor deficiencies**
- **As of 8/30/24 there are 6 outstanding failed properties – to note 3 of these properties have had tenants removed and are in the process of being rehabbed before renting again.**

Fire Chief's Report for August 2024

FIRE & EMS Report

Response calls: 61 Fire runs, and 128 EMS calls were made in August for a total of 189 calls for service.

CPR: There was one CPR class in August. We will be scheduling some community CPR classes in the upcoming months.

Training: Members have completed 1512 hours of training through the month of August. Topics this month included Water Supply/Pumps, SOP/SOG review and Boat operations. EMS training was Asthma/COPD/Respiratory, and St. Elizabeth Simulation Lab. Our training requirements restart every January and include at least 100 hours of Fire, and 40 hours of EMS training per person.

FIRE INSPECTIONS

Crews completed 2 inspections in August.

KNOX BOX PROGRAM

No new Knox Boxes were installed in August.

BURN PERMITS

Open burning is now prohibited in the cities until October.

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

We attended several back-to-school events throughout the cities. Our on-duty crew took part in the active shooter training with Bellevue PD. I attended a large-scale exercise on the B & B Riverboats. Final meetings were held for the annual Riverfest event. We had our bi-monthly fire board meeting. We continue to be two members short of full staffing.
