Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:	
	<ul> <li>Address, Phone Number, and Contact Information</li> <li>Payment Status and Payment History</li> <li>Vehicle Information and Credit Information</li> </ul>	
	When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Payix Incorporated chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Payix Incorporated protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.			
How does Payix Incorporated collect my personal information? Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  None			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Payix Incorporated may share your information with your auto lender if you link an account.			
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Payix Incorporated may share your information with your auto lender if you link an account.			

## Other important information

State and Local Regulations: If, in addition to federal law, you are protected by specific state or local rules concerning information sharing and marketing, Payix Incorporated will comply with those regulations as well.

Use of Third Parties: We have arrangements with other companies who provide services to us. These companies work at our direction, only receive the information needed to perform the functions, and are required to follow our security guidelines.
