INTERVENTION OF THE CENTRAL PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA IN KOREA

Note by the President

The General Assembly, at its 327th plenary meeting held on 1 February 1951, adopted, on the report of the First Committee, resolution 498 (V) which, interalia, "Affirms that it continues to be the policy of the United Nations to bring about a cessation of hostilities in Korea and the achievement of United Nations objectives in Korea by peaceful means, and requests the President of the General Assembly to designate forthwith two persons who would meet with him at any suitable opportunity to use their good offices to this end."

2. The President of the General Assembly has the honour to inform the Members of the Assembly that Mr. Sven Grafstrom of Sweden and Dr. Luis Padilla Nervo of Mexico have accepted his invitation to form with him the Good Offices Committee as provided in the above-mentioned resolution.
