

The accident took place on this spot.

She frequently went to the temple in those days.

Madhavi spoke to me in a very rude manner.

I can pay the amount to you at this very moment.

The news of Sudha Rani's elopement spread in all directions.

 Noun Phrase: A group of words which does the work of a noun is called a Noun Phrase.

Ex: early to bed reading books

to win the race playing cricket

teaching English smoking cigars

Ex: Early to bed is a good habit.

Reading books gives us knowledge and pleasure.


