Restart Plan for Nursing Programs

Licensed Practical Nursing, Bilingual Licensed Practical Nursing, and AAS in Nursing (LPN-to-RN Bridge Program)

July 14, 2021

Following New Jersey Governor Murphy's Executive [Order 244](#) ending the public health emergency due to COVID-2019, President Eastwick lifted all related restrictions at the Ramsey, Hackensack, and Nutley campuses, effective July 6, 2021.

Guidelines for Nursing Students

- Full in-person instruction will resume with the new academic term on July 26, 2021.
- Temperature scanning will not be required.
- Social distancing will not be enforced.
- Masks will not be required. However, students who are not fully vaccinated (i.e., two weeks receiving a single-dose vaccine or the second dose of a two-dose vaccine) are advised to wear a mask.
- Vaccination will not be required. However, all nursing students are encouraged to become vaccinated. Clinical sites may deny access to students who are not fully vaccinated.
- Students who develop fever and respiratory symptoms must refrain from coming to campus and immediately notify Ms. Emma Nabo, director of nursing (201.488.9400 – enabo@eastwick.edu). Ms. Nabo will provide further guidance about missed academic work and requirements to return to school.
- Nursing students in campus laboratory settings must comply with the [Standard Precautions](#) of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention as determined by the nursing instructor.
- Students in clinical sites must comply will the Standard Precautions and all additional requirements of the hosting institution.
