Dear Electrical License Holder,

This letter is to inform you that it is time again to renew your Electrical License for 2025 with the City of Elkhart. All licenses will expire on the last day of December 2024. You may renew as soon as December 1st, 2024. You can renew your license either **online** or you can **mail it in** (see below instructions for both online submittals and mail-in submittals). Please refer to the attached renewal checklist and keep in mind that any renewal submissions that are missing any of the items from the checklist will NOT be accepted.

Mail-In Submittal:

- A completed **2025 Electrical License Application** (must be the ORIGINAL application with the LICENSEE's signature. A copy of the application will NOT be accepted)
- Copy of your **State ID/License** (cannot be expired)
- Check for **\$100** (made out to the City of Elkhart)
- Please mail in all of the above items to the address listed below:

Online Submittal:

If you do not already have an account in our NEW Permitting & License Portal, then you will need to create one via the following link: https://www.civictgov4.com/in_elkhart/portal/ (select **Register** to create an account and once your account has been approved by staff, you will then be able to login and set your password)

- **To renew your license:** login to your account
- Select **My Licenses** and then select **Renew** next to your current license.
- Please be sure to attach a copy of your **Driver's License** on **Step 6** of the renewal application. **Failure to do so will result in your application being rejected.**
- Office Staff will review your application and send you an invoice. Once the invoice has been paid, Office Staff will email you your 2025 Electrical License.
- If you cannot find your license on your account, please contact Aimee Lattimer, at (574)322-4836.

Please remember that it is the electrical contractor's responsibility to **obtain a permit prior to starting a project** and to **call for inspections including the final inspection**. A general contractor or building owner

cannot call in on your behalf. When calling for inspections please try to give us as much notice as possible. Also, Indiana is still using the **2008** National Electrical Code.

Reminder: The final deadline for renewing your license is **January 31, 2025**. After this date you will either have to **retake the masters test** or **reciprocate** back into the City of Elkhart. Either way, it will cost you more money to get your license back.
