


INTERACT Annual meeting held online

Due to the current covid-19 situation, INTERACT Annual meeting was held online during 23-24 September. 92 participants from 16 countries met online. Although a face-to-face meeting would have been an even better platform to create synergies and cooperation, we are all very grateful for the technical possibility to gather this many people and still ensuring that we are taking our social responsibility and mitigate the risk of spreading covid-19. The first day was spent on a workshop focusing on AI and machine learning led by Work Package 6 in INTERACT III, and the second day consisted of the first annual General Assembly for INTERACT III and its second Station Managers' Forum. INTERACT TA Call closed

The TA/RA Call closed on the 15th October 2020 for access taking place in the summer season of 2021 and autumn/winter 2021-22. We received 82 applications, all eligible, for 3469 days of access in total and 627 000 EUR for travel and logistic costs. This is approximately 75% of the record amount of applications we received a year ago for the final TA/RA Call in INTERACT II.



New INTERACT-ive online tools

Each station providing Trans-National, Remote or Virtual Access have identified one or more societal challenges, to which their facilities are especially suitable to respond to by research. The resulting **Infrastructure Matrix** can be used to identify the stations, which would be best suited for your research. Find the Infrastructure Matrix and instructions how to use it here.

Access Modality Selection Tool helps you to choose a suitable modality of access: Trans-National, Remote or Virtual Access, or a

INTERACT at meetings

INTERACT has had a busy autumn presenting our project and progress in different online fora:

On the 25 November, INTERACT was presented at the Arctic and Antarctic Days in Moscow, an online meeting where Russia presented the program for its chairmanship of the Arctic Council in 2021–2023. INTERACT Scientific Coordinator participated in a panel discussion on "Arctic and Antarctic – A territory of sustainable development, harmony of nature and human being".

On the 19 November, INTERACT was presented at the NSERC PermafrostNet & Canadian Permafrost Association Joint Virtual Annual General Meeting 2020 in a session called "Making new connections: International Partners".

On the 11 November, INTERACT was presented at the Artic Science Ministerial Meeting 3 Webinar "Addressing Gaps and Barriers in International Arctic Science Research".

On the 2-3 November, INTERACT was presented in the E-exhibition at the meeting "Arena for the gap analysis of the existing Arctic Science Co-Operations (AASCO)".

On the 27 October, the EU Polar Cluster had its annual meeting and INTERACT, who is a member of the cluster, was present.



New Station joining the INTERACT Network

The Stanisław Baranowski University of Wrocław Polar Station in Svalbard has joined the INTERACT network as an Observer Station. The station was opened in 1971 and is located about 1.5 km from the center of the Werenskiold Glacier. It is open during Arctic summer months (July - September) and supports glaciological, hydrological, geomorphological, geological, geochemical and botanical research.




D1.13 – Innovation Monitoring Plan

To determine impacts and improvements of INTERACT III project, several metrics (i.e. system of measurement) have been developed to quantify innovation. The innovation management (Task 1.3 – watch dog) will consist of a continuous evaluation throughout the project of the INTERACT Innovation Factors for each WP, measuring both internal (INTERACT Network Effects) and external (Stakeholders) potential impacts. Proper indicators have been proposed and approved by WP leaders. To evaluate the innovation impacts from all parts of the project, KPIs (Key Performance Indicators) will be periodically collected and reported.

M1.2 "General Assembly". This milestone was reached on the 24th of September 2020 together with Milestone M2.2 "SMF Meeting 2".
