A great quail gun

Many years back I was invited to go on my first, of what has turned out to be many, quail hunts. Needless to say I was excited and looking forward to a new experience. Little did I know that it would lead me to chasing these amazing little birds all over the country.

The morning of that first hunt found me uncasing my favorite semi-automatic 12 gauge. I soon noticed the strange looks my fellow quail hunters were shooting my direction as they uncased their smaller gauge, double guns.

The Tempio features a trim, hand-rubbed, oil finished stock and a hand-polished, coin finish, low-profile receiver. New for 2016 is an upgrade in engraving that features a contemporary style of "ornato" scroll with tasteful gold accents. When you pick up a Caesar Guerini field gun you will

instantly notice how the gun is balanced near the hinge point. This distributes the weight evenly between your hands, a welcomed feature on your finer upland guns.

Should a Caesar Guerini owner run into a problem with their Tempio, or any other of their models for that matter, you can rest easily knowing they stand behind their products with a lifetime warranty. That is a commitment to you the hunter. Their service does not stop when you buy your shotgun. Owners may also use their PitStop Program up to three times in the lifetime of their shotgun! Just mail your "Guerini" in for a factory tune-up. All you have to pay is the shipping. The PitStop will go through your gun and get it back in top condition, ready for the next season.

So this year, don't be "that guy." Instead, check out the Tempio from Caesar Guerini.
