PROGRAM STRUCTURE:

INCLUSIONS:

Accommodations: Each student will have a single room with private bathroom. Rooms are arranged in 8 - 12 clusters, and each cluster has a fully-equipped kitchen. A complimentary breakfast will be served daily at student accommodations.

- Explore Barcelona's thriving tapas culture
- Tour of Antoni Gaudi's architectural landmarks, the Sagrada Familia & Park Güell
- Site visit to the Cathedral of Barcelona
