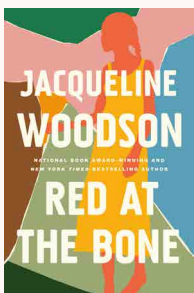
In the wake of an affair, the lives of an astronaut and a radical are forever altered by the political fault lines of the 1960s
