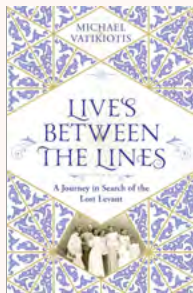

The construction of the Suez Canal in 1869 opened the door of opportunity for people living on the fringes of a turbulent Europe. The Middle East is understood today through the lens of unending conflict. Lost are the layers of culture and civilisation that accumulated over centuries. It gave the region known as the Levant its cosmopolitan identity amid a bewildering mix of races and religions.

Michael Vatikiotis's family was a product of this forgotten pluralist tradition: people set adrift who built new lives and prospered in holy lands, only to be caught up in conflict and tossed on the waves of a violent history.
