Why Home-Based Primary Care (HBPC)?

What is Home-Based Primary Care?

- **A model of care that brings physicians and modern technology to patients in the comfort of their homes**
- **Improves quality of life for medically complex patients and their caregivers**
- **Prevents avoidable hospitalizations and nursing home placements**
- **Dramatically reduces health care costs**

What Does HBPC Offer?

The Quadruple Aim

- **Better outcomes**
- **Improved patient experience**
- **Lower cost of care**
- **Greater job satisfaction for physicians and staff**



HBPC Clinical Care Models & Patient Identification


- **Transitional Care**

- Short-term interventional support
- Suitable for patients of any age with high readmission risk, chronic conditions, and for non-adherent patients

- **Longitudinal Care**

- Long-term medical oversight
- Suitable for patients age 65+ with advanced and/or chronic illness, well as younger patients with chronic conditions, physical or emotional disability, and for patients of any age who are high ED utilizers or have challenges seeing PCP in office/clinic setting
