

## Custom Narcan / Naloxone Overdose Emergency Cabinets for State and County Health Departments



- Our metal cabinets use a Velcro back plate to display medication to create visual “familiarity” and to accommodate the medication whether it is in its original box or placed in the cabinet as separate doses.
- The size of our cabinet and the recessed back plate allow us to store a full-sized 8.5 x 11 laminated instruction sheet for the medication of your choice (Narcan etc.) so that in an emergency a Good Samaritan who is unfamiliar with Narcan, can quickly figure it out and use it without having to unfold one of those accordion-style pharma company instruction leaflets where the font size is tiny.
- The Opioid crisis is not happening in a vacuum. States are also rapidly adapting public access approaches to Stop The Bleed kits and Epinephrine for allergic reactions. Our cabinets utilize magnetic lettering on the outside of the cabinet in case you (or your stakeholders) ever want to add additional medications or devices to the cabinet. New labels sold separately.
- We make the best signage on the market. Even companies with other storage solutions buy our sign, which is a metal, projecting (sticks out from the wall) design available in red or purple.
- This is a medical grade metal cabinet intended to last 20+ years. Made in USA
- Includes mounting hardware and anchors for brick/concrete or drywall. Can be hung by any maintenance staff with a drill and a level.
- Our cabinet is the only one on the market available with magnetic labeling, in case you ever need to add signage/wording for additional medications or emergency supplies added to existing cabinets. For instance, to add a tourniquet kit or EpiPens (many states are passing laws regarding these items)
- Cabinet does not include medication.

Our three-dimensional signs project out from the wall so they are visible from either direction down busy corridors:



Our instruction sheets were designed knowing that in an emergency, people are not going to unfold a tiny instruction booklet. You only have precious minutes to reverse respiratory depression:

### How to use Narcan Nasal Spray.

Before use, check for signs of opioid overdose:  
• Ask the patient if they feel dizzy or have trouble breathing. Have them lie on their back.  
• Check for their eyes to look normal, conscious and not "pupils wide."  
• Lay the person flat back to receive a dose of NARCAN Nasal Spray.

<p>1. Hold back the package to remove the device. Hold the device with your thumb on the bottom of the package (not the top) or the nozzle.</p>	<p>2. Place the tip of the nozzle in the nostril and your fingers on the bottom of the person's nose. The person's head back and possible support under the neck with your hand nearby. Tilt the head of the nostril into a nose, and your fingers at the side of the nostril to support the bottom of the person's nose.</p>	<p>3. Press the plunger firmly right in front of NARCAN Nasal Spray into the nostril. Breathe normally. Do not breathe from the nozzle after giving the dose.</p> <p>Repeat the process on the other nostril as you proceed. After giving NARCAN Nasal Spray.</p>

4. Get emergency medical help right away:  
• Monitor the person's breathing. If the person does not respond to NARCAN, or breathing normally and does not respond to NARCAN, call 911.  
• NARCAN Nasal Spray may be stored every 2 to 3 minutes, if available.  
• Repeat steps 1-3 every 2-3 minutes until you see the person breathe or until other help arrives.  
• If additional doses of Narcan Nasal Spray are available, repeat steps 1-3 on each side of the person's nostrils and the person's nostrils and/or emergency medical help is needed.

NARCAN (Naloxone Hydrochloride) is a prescription drug. It is not for use in children under the age of 18. It is not for use in pregnant women. Use only as directed. See the NARCAN Nasal Spray package insert for more information.
