Instructions for Submitting Form DS-3053:

- 1. **Complete the form**: The non-applying parent or guardian must fill out the form completely and accurately.
- 2. **Notarize the form**: The consent section must be signed in the presence of a Notary Public, who will notarize the form.
- Submit the form: The completed and notarized form should be submitted along with Form DS-11 by the parent or guardian who is applying with the minor at a passport acceptance facility
