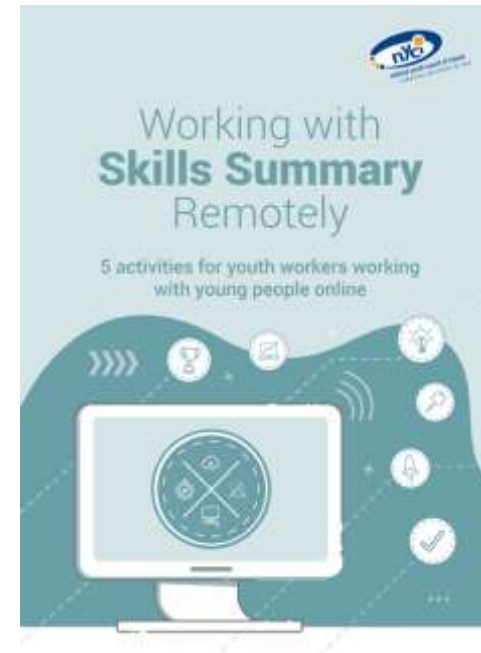
- ✓ Developed in a collaborative project between the National Youth Council of Ireland, Accenture and SpunOut.ie
